Raising youth and public awareness

COP in MyCity is a youth-led project which ambitions is to bridge the gap between climate negotiations (a.k.a. the COPs) and youth in order to inspire climate action in all cities of the world.



“Climate cooperation is in our hands”

Three major steps:

- **Before the COP** : Learn

> Training and conferences on climate change the COPs

> Simulation of international negotiations

- **During the COP** : Act in your city

> mobilisation

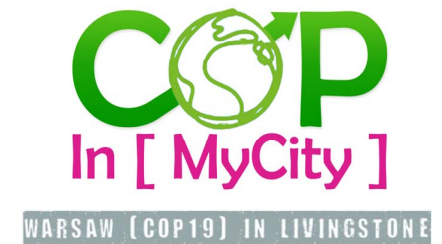
> empowerment

- **After the COP** : Debrief and get stronger for next year



“Climate cooperation is in our hands”

- In 2013:
 - 19 cities from the five continents
 - 46 events of mobilisation
 - 17 simulations
 - 1300 youth reached
- In 2014
 - 50 cities
 - a side-event at the COP20
 - more than 3000 youth reached



=> a worldwide youth mobilisation for the COP21 in December 2015
