Objective

To provide a flexible framework for National Focal Points for Article 6 of the Convention that facilitates:

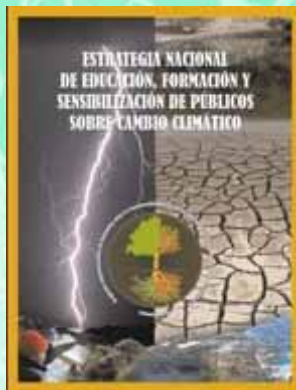
- development and implementation of a national strategy and an action plan on Article 6 of the Convention;
- mobilization of technical and financial support from national and external sources;
- establishment of cross-sectoral cooperative arrangements;
- monitoring, reporting and evaluation of progress.





Guiding principles

- A country-driven process;
- National needs, circumstances and priorities;
- A long-term and strategic approach;
- A multi-sectoral and multi-stakeholder participation;
- Linkages with national sustainable development objectives;
- Coherence with existing adaptation and mitigation programmes and strategies.
