Background Information

EcoZone Summer Camp

- 4 week camp for children aged 5 to 14
- The curriculum encompasses:
 - Endangered species
 - Endemic species
 - Invasive alien species
 - Habitats
- Activities include:
 - Field trips
 - Arts and craft
 - Drama and singing
 - Cookery
 - Horseback riding







EcoZone Summer Camp

- Ways that Article 6 is discussed:
 - Climate change has a direct effect on wildlife that live on our islands by changing habitats
 - The wildlife are also effected by what man has done,
 and continues to do
- Children learn:
 - To appreciate the wildlife that live on the islands
 - To understand that their actions can have positive and negative impacts on the environm

Arbour Month

- Objectives:
 - To instill the importance of planting trees,
 particularly in a country that is so vulnerable
 - To instill the importance of proper land clearing techniques, as improper practices increase vulnerability
 - To reduce our carbon footprint



Arbour Month (contd)

Activities:

- Newspaper articles on: mangroves, importance of trees, trees and their link to clean and healthy waterways, invasive species, food security
- Workshops on tree maintenance
- Talk shows discussing medicinal value and importance of planting
- Plant Fair (Clean Air Sale)


Environmental Cadet Programme

- School extra curricular activity presently in 36 schools
- Activity-based programme targeting primary, secondary and tertiary levels
- Clean Green Campaign (2010/2011) focus areas:
 - Energy Conservation
 - Ecosystems
 - Biodiversity
 - Sustainable Living
- Each project has a Public Information Campaign (PIC) component.
- The Objective of this Programme is to enable the cadets to create tangible change within the environment that filters through to the general public.

Environmental Cadet Programme (contd)

- Ecosystems
 - Save the Mangroves
 - Ecology of a tree/area
