

Implementation of Teachers Learning Program on CC with more than 1000 teachers trained


### SICA Regional Climate Change Strategy

JUNE - Formal request received by UN CC:Learn from SICA members, June 2014

SEPT – SICA declaration on climate change learning, in Santo Domingo

OCT – Presentation of SICA programme to UN CC:Learn Steering Committee

NOV - Official acceptance provided by UN CC:Learn

JAN 2015 - Official acceptance by CCAD-SICA

JUNE 2015 - Detailed technical and financial proposal to be submitted

# Vision for a Regional Programme on Climate Change Learning

Supports implementation of the SICA Regional Climate Change Strategy (2010), specifically Programme Area 4

Takes advantage of regional synergies while focusing on national level implementation activities.

Starts with a two-year pilot phase with the aim to establish a longterm regional collaboration programme.

### Objectives of the Regional Programme

- Improve personal and social resilience and enable informed and high quality public debate on Climate Change in Central America;
- Leverage the experience of SICA members states in climate change learning and create common initiatives and access more funding;
- Strengthen regional diplomacy and coordination on climate change.

CCAD with national and international resources




Pilot phase 2015-2017

### Elements of Pilot Phase (2015-2017)

- Stocktaking and Assessment of Climate Change Learning Needs and Delivery Capacities
- 2. Development of a Regional Implementation Action Plan
- 3. Implementation of prioritized Strategic Action in SICA countries
- 4. Regional Forum
- 5. Resource mobilization for full implementation phase
- 6. Evaluation

### Institutional Set-Up



### **Finance**

Pilot phase (2015-2017):

- Total costs 600,000 USD
- 280,000 USD provided through UN CC:Learn (requiring at least 1:1 co-financing)

Full implementation phase (2017-2021):

1 million per year
