Livestock census and forest inventory was conducted in 1993/1994. stakeholders contributed by

filling in or responding to the survey questionnaire.

The National Climate committee was established in 1992 with 12 institutions represented. 1 lady was among:

Presently there are 35 members with 2 ladies

The first greenhouse gas inventory carried out in 1994 with grassroots consultations. Both the census and the GHG inventory was sponsored by the U.S. Country studies

The Initial National Communications (INC) was preceded by stakeholder consultations by the MEA at the District, Divisional and Policy makers levels

The District report was presented at the Divisional levels, the divisional level report was presented to policy makers workshop at the level of Permanent Secretaries

#### Public Participation - INC

The Initial National Communications (INC) was carried out in 1999 and presented to the Conference of Parties (COP) in 2003. During the process all relevant stakeholder consultation was conducted

#### Public Participation - INC

During the process, businesses were particularly targeted and as such, the focal point sent letters to them explaining the importance of the questionnaire and the value of genuine data provided

#### Public Participation - INC

A highly excellent, voluminous and technical document was produced with a chapter on Article 6. The document was distributed to institutions like forestry, energy, agriculture, health, water resources coastal protection, water resources etc.

#### Public Participation – ARWA 6

The Gambia hosted the Africa Regional workshop in 2004, opened by the Minister of Environment and attended by relevant Ministers, Local Government officers

#### Public Participation – 8 Workshops

The simplified INC was preceded by eight regional workshops in the Gambia. Participants included men, women and youths.

#### Public Participation – Booklet

■ The INC was simplified into A5 booklet for grade 4 school going age to policy makers level. The booklets were distributed to schools and institutions. It is more user friendly.

There is a proliferation of youth groups in the Gambia including; Global unification, children to children, concern universal, phoenix, climate change women's group, ENDA's interventions

- The Gambia prepared and submitted its NAPA
- Three year greenhouse gas inventory project implemented with studies in the energy, agriculture and forestry sectors

- The Second National Communications is being implemented and the chapter on Article 6 is complete
- During the preparation of the Article 6 Chapter questionnaire were filled/responded by those who have stake in the climate.

- Article 6 questionnaire were filled/responded up to the level of the Vice President's office.
- Two were sent to the president's office and we still await the response

The UNFCCC focal point, Article 6 focal point, the permanent secretary Min. of Forest and Environment, the media, the NAPA coordinator had TV programmes sensitizing the public on climate change

- World environment day
- World meteorology day
- World water day
- All these international days include CC talk and are celebrated with a wide range of stakeholder involvement

 The UN human development report in a changing climate was presented by UNDP in 2008

 A policy makers workshop on climate change was organized in 2008. Participants included Secretary General of WMO, a representative of the UNFCCC Executive Secretary

- The vice president and all the Minister who were in Gambia at the time participated in the policy makers workshop
- All media participated

 In collaboration with UNDP, the Gambia was well represented at COP 15 with the vice president and the media present

 The disaster management team have radio and TV programmes where climate change is very well discussed

 The global unification in collaboration with Action Aid is presently implementing radio programmes exclusively on climate change

#### Way Forward

- Continue public awareness activities.
- Revisit and implement the strategy in the Article 6 chapter contained in the SNC
- Seek bilateral/multilateral to implement actions of the strategy
