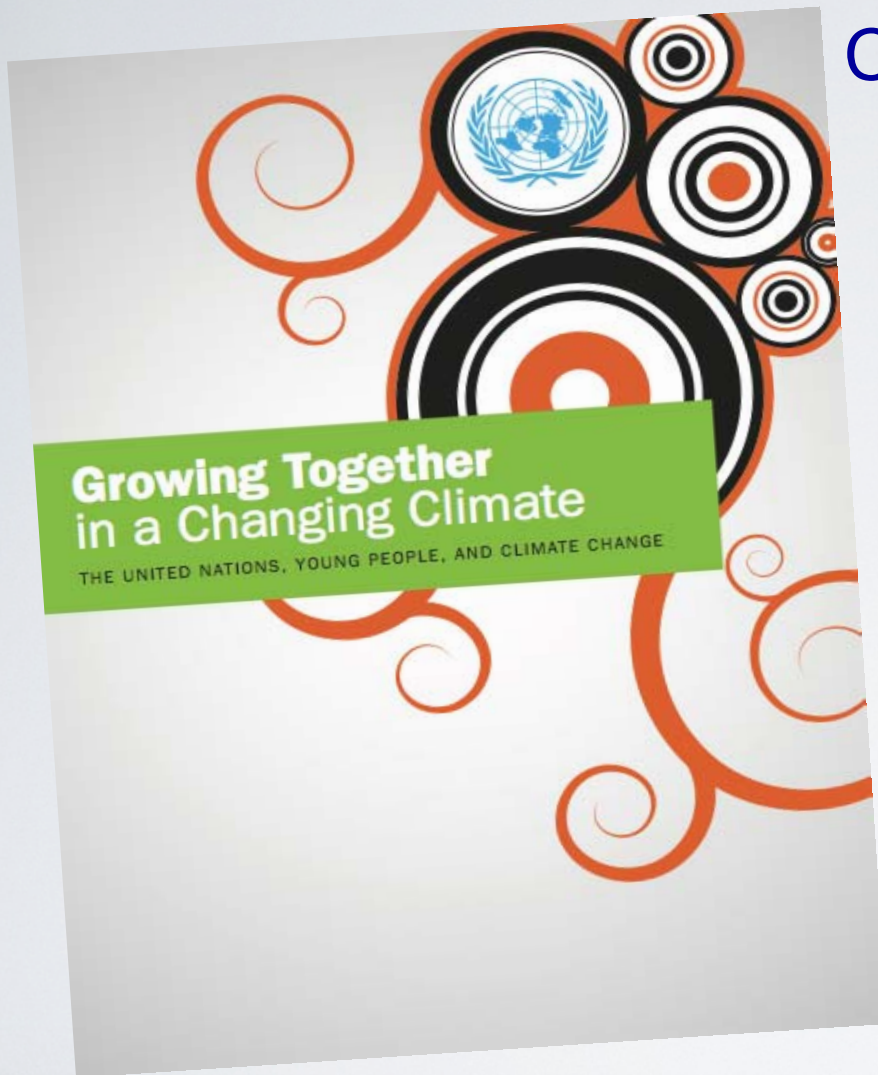


Joint Framework Initiative on Children, Youth and Climate Change

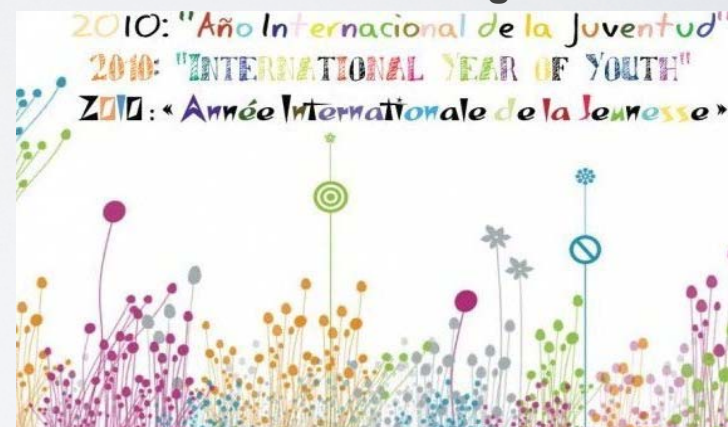
