## Climate change education in Seychelles islands

The presentation emphasized the vulnerability of the Seychelles to climate change impact, such as sea-level rise, coral bleaching, water resources and severe natural disasters, and showcased education and awareness activities and strategies school children, who play an important role in educating their parents on environmental issues.

These include: compulsory environmental education in teachers' training; integration of climate change in geography and science curricula, extra curricula activities such as echo-school programme, and annual environmental education calendar. The presentation also showcased partnership activities with decision-makers, the private sector and the public, such as and marches and rallies for the environment; as well as participation in the UNESCO sandwatch project, with the beaching monitoring and rehabilitation project.
