OBJECTIVES(S)

The aim of this side event is to present the 'Summary and Recommendations of the SCF on the 2014 Biennial Assessment and Overview of Climate Finance Flows'¹. Specific objectives include:

- Introduce the key findings and recommendations;
- Discuss how the BA can help promote improvements in the evolving MRV system of the Convention; and
- Exchange views and ideas on how to build confidence on the quality of data and information on climate finance flows, including though implementation of recommendations by SCF.

FOCUS

The side event presents an opportunity for the SCF to present the key findings and recommendations to a broader audience. It will focus on climate finance flows for the period 2011-2012, and ways through which quality of measurement and reporting can be improved, both within and outside of the Convention.

A brief presentation and panel discussions will draw from the 'Summary and recommendations by the Standing Committee on Finance on the 2014 Biennial Assessment and Overview of Climate Finance Flows' contained in Annex II of the SCF report to COP20.² The discussions may be supplemented with information from the 2014 BA report (technical report).

PARTICIPATITON

The side event will be chaired by SCF co-chairs with active participation of the BA co-facilitators and SCF members involved in the preparation of the 2014 BA.

The event is open to Parties and observers, including climate finance tracking and reporting community.

FORMAT

Opening remarks followed by one brief presentation, panel discussions, and moderated interactive segment with participants in a lively roundtable conversation style.
