Liechtenstein's Fast Start Finance, Experiences so far

- December 2009 – by joining the chapeau to the Copenhagen Accord Liechtenstein declared its political will to contribute to FSF
- December 2010 - Decision by the Liechtenstein Parliament to add to the budget line „International Humanitarian Cooperation and Development“ an amount of USD 700'000 (for 2011 and 2012 as **new, additional and unconditional grants**);
- FSF amount is based on a formula, taking into account the **level of emissions, the financial capacity and the population size**.
- November 2012 – Decision by Liechtenstein Parliament to continue Climate Finance by granting another USD 600'000 until at least 2015.

Primary goal of Liechtenstein's FSF framework is the delivery of effective results and benefits that address sustainable development and climate change needs (mitigation and adaptation), therefore Liechtenstein FSF projects should:

- Show a need driven approach – projects are developed by recipients and reflect their priorities;
- Allow recipients to gain ownership of the processes and projects;
- Support socially, economically and environmentally friendly initiatives;
- Contribute to solve gender conflicts, empowering women, raising awareness among young people and civil society and finally strengthening peace and security



Further Involvement of Private Sector:

During Liechtenstein's FSF period 2010 – 2012 the per capita contribution in FSF increased from

USD 10,- / Inhabitant – 2010

USD 20,- / Inhabitant – 2011

USD 30,- / Inhabitant – 2012

USD ??,- / Inhabitant – 2020

due to successfull launch of several PPP projects – supported by Liechtenstein's private sector (e.g. philantropic foundations, family offices)
