Decision 5/CP.20 defines that the in-session workshops **in 2015 and 2016** will focus on the issues of:

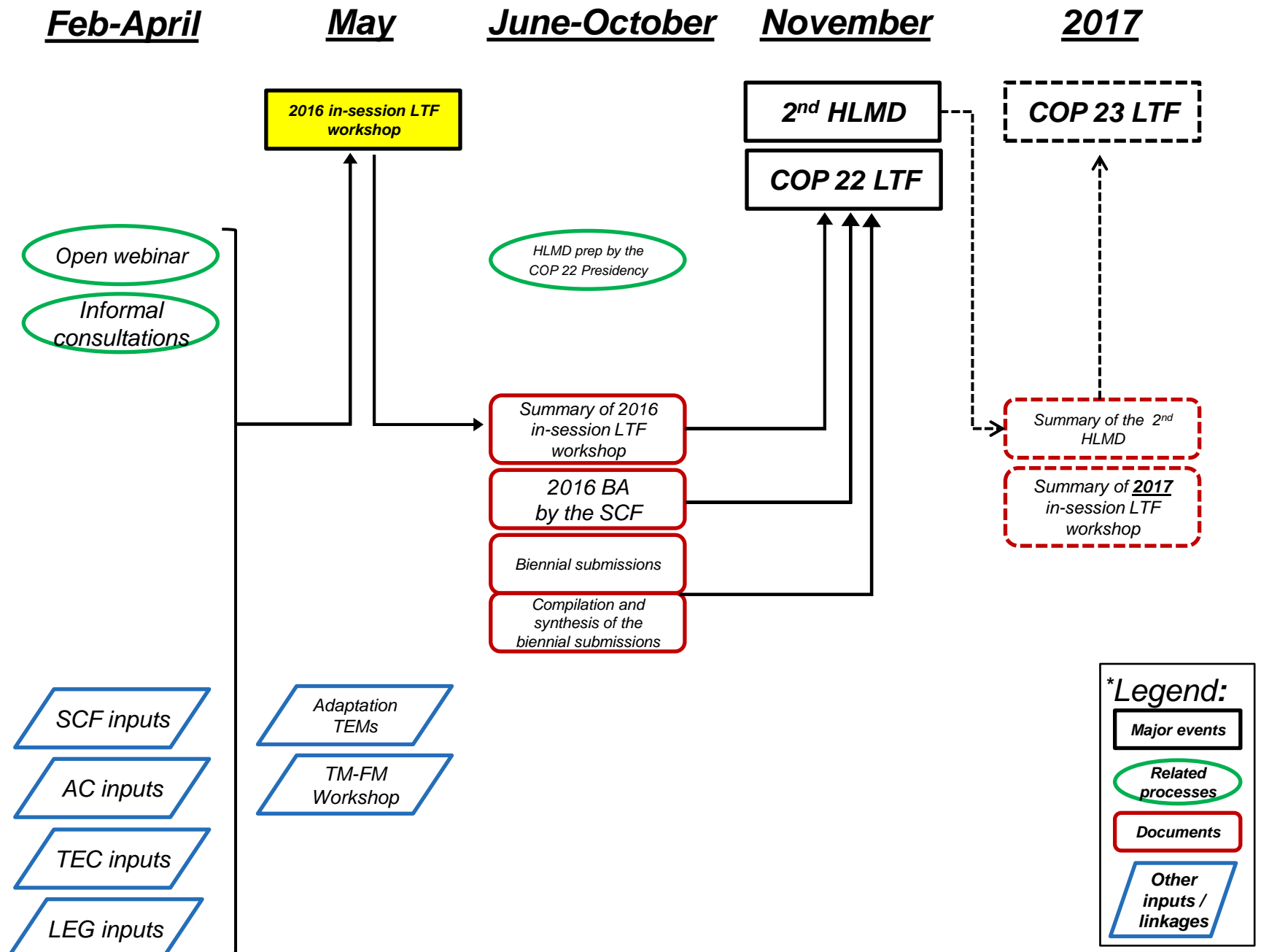
- adaptation finance
