Frequently Asked Questions

Can others see information I enter in the registry?

Yes, other information published in the registry is public. Draft submissions are not public.

My country submitted information on NAMAs to the secretariat under the process for early submission of information to the registry. Do I need to resubmit this information?

No, this information has been transferred into the registry and does not need to be re-entered. Parties are encouraged to validate this information to ensure that no errors have occurred in the process of transcribing information into the registry.

How can I get access rights to create entries in the registry?

Access rights can be obtained from the secretariat. Find out more about the different kinds of access rights and how to apply for them here.

Where can I find out how to use the registry?,

Is there a time limit on submitting information to the registry?

➤ No, there is no deadline to enter information into the registry. However the sooner information is entered the sooner it can assist in the matching NAMAs and support.

Do NAMA approvers and NAMA developers use the same template?

Yes, the templates in the registry are the same for NAMA approvers and NAMA developers are identical

Can the templates for entering information be customized to allow parties to enter extra information about NAMAs?

> The templates cannot be changed but they allow attachments containing extra information to be added.
