Current situation

- A Forum established to address the issues of RM
 - Good move
 - A work program developed
- Is/Has the Forum delivered the expectations?
- Some of the issues of the Forum
 - Mixed in nature Political discussions and technical discussions
 - 1 or 2 hours for discussions highly insufficient for many issues to be addressed
 - Give political guidance and technical guidance to Parties Policies need informed decision making
 - This leads to partitioning and fragmenting of outcomes
 - Observers 'observe'

How to tackle the issue ?

- Old saying "Try, Try and Try"
- 10+3x2 = 26 WRONG !!!
- 10+(3x2) = 16 **RIGHT !!!**
- Reformed version is:
 - "Try, learn from mistakes and Try, give a different approach and Try"
- The Forum needs and overhaul under the Paris Agreement
- Main overhaul
 - Have a technical arm
 - Forum undertake informed decision

Functions of the Forum

- Promoting and understanding of the impact of the implementation of response measures
- Provide a platform for Parties to share, in an interactive manner, information, experience, case studies, best practices and views, national approaches being undertaken
- Raise awareness and enhancing the capacity of Parties to assess, address, manage, monitor and report on the impacts of implementation of response measures
- Serving as a platform for implementation and pre-emptive cooperation and stakeholder engagement to address the impacts
 - International organizations, academia
- Review of impacts of implementation of response measures by systematically considering the effects of climate policies ex-ante, during and ex-post
- Identifying and promoting tools and methodologies to assess and address the impacts of the implementation of response measures
- Should have a short and long-term plan
 - Build national capacities
 - Strengthening monitoring and reporting systems
 - Reduce the impact due to implementation of response measures
