1. Opening of the workshop

The pre-sessional workshop on modalities, work programme and functions under the Paris Agreement of the forum on the impact of the implementation of the response measures will be opened by the Chair of the Subsidiary Body on Implementation (SBI) and the Chair of the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA).
