## **Eighth Meeting of the Standing Committee on Finance**

## 1–3 October 2014 Bonn, Germany

Pursuant to decision 2/CP.17, I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations (NGO) that the eighth meeting of the Standing Committee on Finance (SCF) will take place at the Altes Abgeordnetenhochhaus (AHH), UN Campus, Platz der Vereinten Nationen 1, 53113 Bonn, Germany, from 1 to 3 October 2014.

In accordance with the modalities and procedures adopted by decision 2/CP.17, the eighth meeting of the SCF will be open to admitted observer organizations. Representatives from admitted NGOs nominated by the Constituency Focal Points must register for the meeting using the Observer Registration Form for NGOs, which is sent to Constituency Focal Points. Once the Constituency Focal Points confirm the nomination(s), they should forward the registration form to the secretariat using the following email address:

I would like to remind all Constituency Focal Points that the Conference of the Parties, by decision 23/CP.18, invited Parties to commit to meeting the goal of gender balance by, inter alia, nominating women to bodies established under the Convention and its Kyoto Protocol, with the aim of a gradual but significant increase in the participation of women. To this end, I would like to encourage NGO constituencies to adopt a similar approach with regards to gender balance in the nomination of their respective delegations to attend the upcoming meeting.
