Resumed initial meeting of the Executive Committee of the Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage associated with Climate Change Impacts

Bonn, Germany 17–18 September 2014

Pursuant to decision 2/CP.19, I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that the resumed initial meeting of the Executive Committee of the Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage associated with Climate Change Impacts (hereinafter referred to as the Executive Committee) will take place in Bonn, Germany, from 17 to 18 September 2014.

In accordance with decision 2/CP.19, the meeting of the Executive Committee will be open to observers. However, given space limitations, participation may have to be limited.

Representatives from NGOs nominated by the Constituency Focal Point must register for the meeting using the Observer Registration Form for NGOs, which is sent to Constituency Focal Points. Confirmation by the Constituency Focal Point is provided for in the form. The deadline for registration as an observer is <u>Friday</u>, 15 August 2014. In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, please be advised that the secretariat may not be in a position to process observer registrations for NGOs received after this deadline.
