Evolve the carbon market

A new framework to balance the need for both environmental integrity and fungibility of units, as multiple carbon pricing schemes emerge

Develop a new UNFCCC mechanism to ensure a liquid global carbon market.

Engage in specific sectors and/or regional initiatives

- e.g. GRA, CCAC
- Support Fossil Fuel Subsidy Reform
- Total global subsidies of \$400-600bn p.a. (depending on fuel prices).
- Potential to reduce global CO₂ emissions by 10% by 2050.
