

## **Implementation of all elements of decision 1/CP.17**

### **(a) Matters related to paragraphs 2 to 6**

#### **Submission of Algeria**

Algeria welcomes the opportunity offered by the UNFCCC secretariat to submit its views about implementing decision 1/CP.17. In this regard, it emphasizes that the main goal of the ADP process is to strengthen the multilateral rule-based regime, with the full implementation of the Convention and its principles.

Algeria recognizes the need of enhancing the current regime in order to deal dully with climate change and its adverse effects.

On matters related to paragraphs 2 to 6 of decision 1/CP.17, Algeria calls for the consideration of the elements bellow as benchmarks:

- 1) The outcome of the ADP process must be fully conform to the UNFCCC provisions and principles, in particular historical responsibility, equity, common but differentiated responsibilities and respective capacities.
- 2) The outcome should be balanced in dealing with mitigation and adaptation.
- 3) The outcome should give an adequate response to the issue of finance, which must be adequate, predictable, new and additional.
- 4) On technology transfer and capacity building, the outcome should contain an efficient mechanism to disseminate a “friendly climate technology”. For that, it is essential to enhance the participation of developing countries through an adequate research and development work program under the UNFCCC and relevant institutions.
