

#### Options related to work at technical and political levels

#### Work at technical level


- Technical expert meetings on a broad range of thematic areas, e.g. HFCs and REDD-plus
- Detailed technical processes with a timeline and focus on areas with mitigation potential
  - Workshops, mitigation action plans and implementation work
- Work programme under SBSTA on technical work and dialogue

#### Work at political level

- Importance of strong political signal
- Clear plan for ministerial involvement on ambition and support in 2014
- Kyoto Protocol ambition mechanism and Ministerial round table, June 2014
- Inputs for UN SG's event in Sept' 2014
- Ministerial on WS2 outcome
- Ministerial on options for mitigation actions

## Possible ways forward to enhancing mitigation ambition (1)

- Options to enhance mitigation ambition of actions and support
  - Taking action to enhance mitigation efforts and support in 2014
  - Mobilizing effective support for enhanced action by developing countries
  - Recognizing, scaling up and increasing visibility of actions and cooperative initiatives undertaken by all stakeholders
  - Recognizing early action towards implementation of commitments accounted for under the 2015 agreement
  - Strengthening national processes through the UNFCCC to identify mitigation opportunities and facilitate investment
  - Catalysing REDD-plus actions
  - Invitation to the Montreal Protocol to phase down production and consumption of HFCs



#### Possible ways forward to enhancing mitigation ambition (2)

- Options related to work at technical and political levels
- Continue identification and sharing best practices and success stories
- Continue technical workshops and expert meetings on areas with high mitigation potential
- Clear technical process and direction for political and high level engagement



### Possible ways forward to enhancing mitigation ambition (3)

#### Options to enhance ambition of pledges

- Enhancing pledges and making new more ambitious pledges
- Reaffirming leadership role by developed countries in pledging deeper emission reductions and moving to the upper range of pledges
- Ensuring prompt ratification of the Doha Amendment to the Kyoto Protocol
- Increasing ambition of commitments for the Kyoto Protocol CP2
- Ensuring comparable ambition of pledges and emission reductions under the Convention by non-Kyoto Protocol Parties
- Broadening a scope of pledges by developing countries
- Encouraging voluntary cancellation of CERs as a contribution to enhancing mitigation ambition
