# Purpose, Facts and Means of Support

## Purpose:

- › Demonstrating a framework for providing tailor-made climate finance for developing countries in the field of mitigation.
- › Building on existing support by funding the implementation of transformational NAMAs seeking international support, thus delivering concrete results on the ground.
- › Raising ambition to close the emission gap and address the lack of NAMA climate finance.

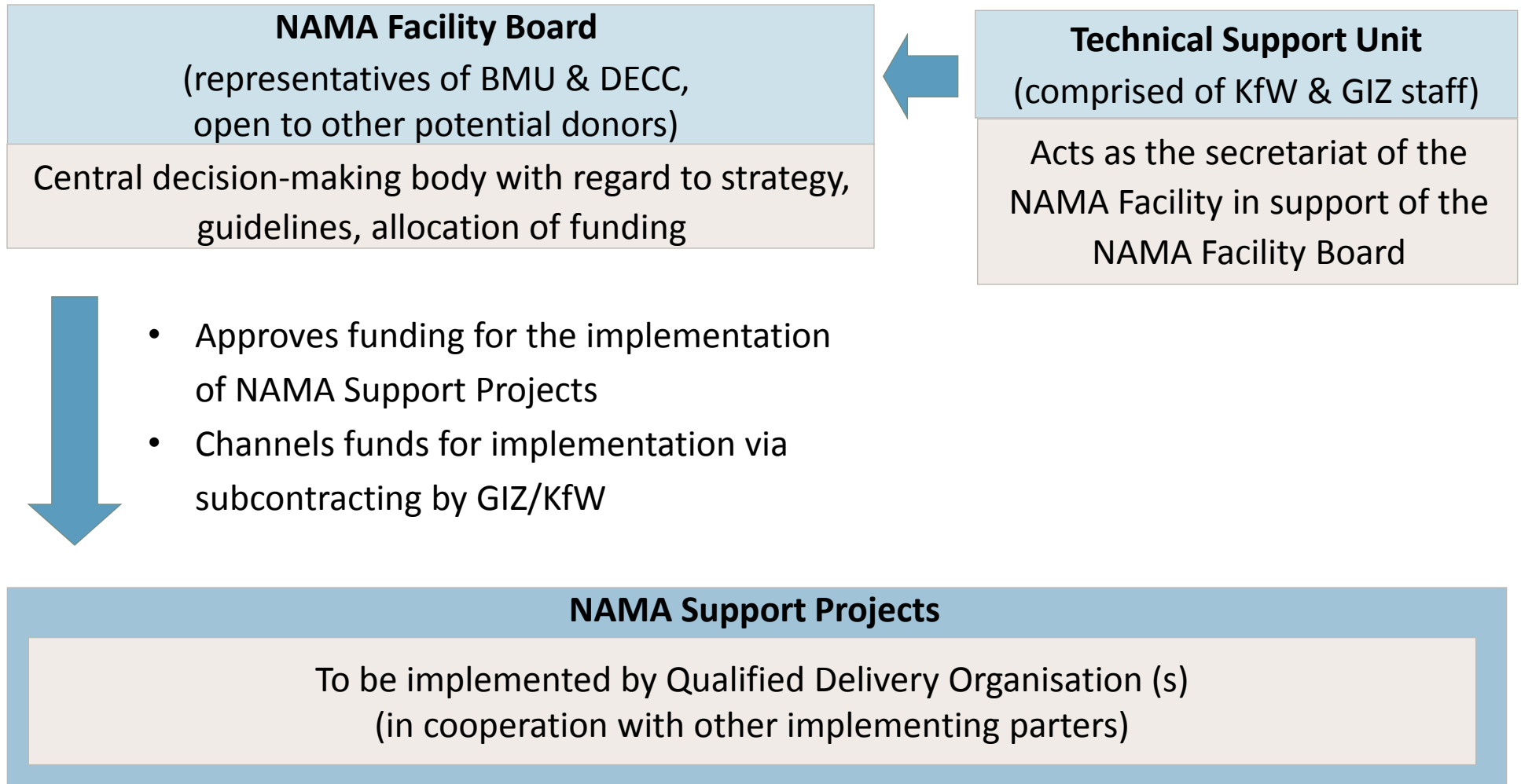
## Facts :

- › Officially announced by Germany and the UK at COP-18 in Doha
- › Germany and the UK are jointly providing € 70m of initial funding (pilot and first call)
- › First pilot programme is the Mexico Housing NAMA



Support for the implementation of parts of NAMAs („**NAMA Support Projects**“) focussing on financial support (e.g. grants, concessional loans, guarantees), with technical cooperation (e.g. capacity building) where combined with or closely linked to financial support

# Selection of NAMA Support Projects Process

**STEP 1:** Call for submissions & submission of outlines for NAMA Support Projects

Verification of Eligibility (General Eligibility Criteria)

Evaluation against Ambition and Feasibility Criteria

External assessment to ensure a rigorous, transparent and unbiased evaluation



- Pre-approval of selected projects by the NAMA Facility Board
- Appraisal mandate for pre-approved NAMA Support Projects

---

**STEP 2:** In-depth appraisal & submission of proposals for NAMA Support Projects

Evaluation against Feasibility Criteria



- Final NAMA Support Project approval by the Board
- Mandate to delivery organisation

**STEP 3:** NAMA Support Project implementation

# The First Call for NAMA Support Project Outlines

- › The first call for NAMA Support project Outlines was open from July 10<sup>th</sup> to September 2<sup>nd</sup> 2013.
- › A total of 47 NAMA Support Project Outlines were submitted.
- › The Outlines received showed a balanced distribution across regions and sectors.
- › The projects are evaluated based on three sets of criteria:
  - › General eligibility
  - › Ambition
  - › Feasibility

# Results of the 1st Call

## Pre-selected NAMA Support Project Outlines

- › The following NAMA Support Project Outlines have been pre-selected for funding from the NAMA Facility.
  - › Chile            Self-Supply Renewable Energy in Chile (SSRE)
  - › Colombia        Transport Oriented Development NAMA
  - › Costa Rica      Low Carbon Coffee NAMA
  - › Indonesia       Sustainable Urban Transport Program (SUTRI NAMA)
  
- › Pre-selected projects will start their appraisal phase as soon as administrative steps are cleared out
  
- › The TSU offers to provide feedback to all countries and delivery organisations, whose NAMA Support Project Outlines were not selected during the 1st Call

## Next Steps of the NAMA Facility

- › The € 70m from the initial replenishment have been fully committed.
- › BMU and DECC will commit additional funds of € 50 million.
- › A second call to be launched in mid-2014.
- › Other donors are invited to join.
