In order to achieve pre-2020 emission reduction pledges and targets of nationally determined contributions (NDCs) under the Paris Agreement, a wide variety of initiatives and actions must be taken by a range of state and non-state actors, including sub-national governments, cities and citizens. The sub-national governments, cities and citizens have huge opportunities to contribute for mitigating climate change but various barriers prevent these opportunities from being fully realized. The main objective of the session is to explore ways to horizontally expand and accelerate climate actions at all level, with a focus on strengthening the links between the national and sub-national/local processes to raise the level of climate ambition (Pre-2020 and NDCs).
