Examples of structural proposals

- Move to section on **Implementation:**
 - Section on Risk reduction, management and sharing
 - All provisions related to support for adaptation
- Move to section **Institutional arrangements:**
 - All aspects related to institutional arrangements
- Move to section **Risk reduction, management and sharing:**
 - Aspects of micro insurance and risk pooling
- Add:
 - A new section on ‘**Research and Systematic Observation**’



Examples of structural proposals

Structural changes that are cross-cutting with other chapters of the revised negotiating text

- Move to chapter I on shared vision:
 - Overarching **objectives** and **principles**
- Move to chapter IV on finance, technology and capacity-building:
 - Aspects related to adaptation **support**
