

Bolivia proposal 13 Dec 2009

Integration into paragraph 23

23. The shared vision for long-term cooperative action includes:

- (a) A shared vision and goal on adaptation **focused on the provision by developed countries of means of implementation to developing countries to facilitate adequate adaptation to climate change, to meet the costs of its adverse effects and to repay adaptation debts including through the provision of financial resources by developed countries equivalent to at least 3% of their GNP**
- (b) A shared vision and goal on mitigation **focused on the achievement by Annex I countries that are not party to the Kyoto Protocol of total and domestic emission reductions comparable to those undertaken by Annex I parties to the Kyoto Protocol through a second and subsequent commitment periods, including through quantified changes to the unsustainable patterns of consumption and production by developed countries; and on measures by developing countries to mitigate climate change, including through nationally appropriate mitigation actions in the context of sustainable development supported and enabled by developed countries through, inter alia, the provision of financial resources by developed countries equivalent to at least 1% of their GNP**
- (c) A shared vision and goal on the provision of financial resources ~~and investment~~ **annually to developing country Parties by the developed country Parties through the Convention's financial mechanism of at least six percent (6%) of Annex I Parties' GNP for the full, effective and sustained implementation of the Convention for adaptation, technology transfer, capacity building and mitigation actions of developing countries, as described in subparagraphs (a), (b), (d), and (e) of this paragraph.**
- (d) A shared vision and goal on ~~technology transfer~~ **the transfer of environmentally sound technologies to developing countries and enhancement of their endogenous capacities and technologies in accordance with Articles 4.1, 4.3, 4.4, 4.5 and 4.5, including through the provision of financial resources by developed countries equivalent to at least 1% of their GNP; and identification and removal of all barriers to access to technologies at the most affordable cost and appropriate treatment of intellectual property rights including exclusion of patents on climate related technologies to developing country Parties**
- (e) A shared vision and goal on capacity-building **to enable the upgrading of developing countries' institutional capacities to address climate change and its adverse effects, including through the provision of financial resources by developed countries equivalent to at least 1% of their GNP; and on self-funded capacity-building by developed countries to reduce their high per-person greenhouse gas emissions, to live in harmony with nature and to reduce their climate and ecological debts to developing countries and nature**
- (f) A shared vision and goal on long-term emission reductions **focused on the equitable allocation of the global atmospheric space between developed countries and developing countries during the period 1750 to 2050 based on historical responsibility, the principles of equity and common but differentiated responsibilities and respective capabilities, and the need of developing countries to achieve their first and overriding priorities of economic and social development and poverty eradication**
