

Overview of EU's work on LULUCF data

LULUCF 1st October 2009



30 July 2008 EU submission

- Objective: assessment of different accounting options at EU level.
- Scope: all 3.3 and 3.4 activities
- Based on UNFCCC reporting
- Options assessed:
 - → from current rules to full land based accounting net/net.
- 2 reference periods for net/net accounting: 1990 and 1990-1999



3 June 2009 EU submission

- Objective: assessment of 'Bar/Band' options at EU level.
- Based on UNFCCC reporting + preliminary elements of projection at EU level
- Options assessed in comparison with present rules:
 - Discount factor
 - Bar and Bar/Band approaches based on historical base year or base period.
 - Bar approach using preliminary projections for the period 2013-2020
- Reference levels used: 1990; 2001-2005; BAU projections(2013-2020).



EU submission on forest data (Sept. 2009)

- Objective: provide available forest data to support the decision making process on LULUCF accounting rules
- Scope:
 - forest area
 - GHG emissions and removals (FM, AR, D)
 - natural disturbances,
 - HWP (production and SCAD approaches).
- Data provided at Member State level (27 countries) + aggregated at EU level.



Data and methodologies

- When possible, based on international data bases: UNFCCC, FAO, UNECE, EFFIS.
- Updated with national data + projections when available (see Annex for details).
- Emissions and removals: data processed:
 - attempting to match KP activities → disaggregation into A/R, D and FM
 - using K.Pingoud Model for HWP → IPCC defaults, FAO data; Approaches assessed: Production Approach + SCAD
- Natural disturbances: area data only



Data coverage (1)

- Forest area: 25 Member States
- Emissions and removals:
 - Forest Management: 24 Member States
 - Afforestation / Reforestation: 19 Member
 States
 - Deforestation: 11 Member States



Data coverage (2)

Natural disturbances:

- Fires:
 - Total burnt area for 20 countries (annual reporting)
 - Forest burnt area by 8 countries (annual reporting)
- Other disturbances: less data available and often not comparable.

Wood products:

- Roundwood production: 27 countries
- HWP: 27 countries



Main findings

- Forest area: 155 Mha in 2007; +394 000 ha/yr since 1990.
- Emissions and removals: in 2007:
 - Forest Management: -376 MtCO₂;
 decreasing sink of 1,3MtCO₂/yr
 - A/R: -39 MtCO2;
 increasing sink of 2,1 MtCO₂/yr
 - Deforestation: 19 MtCO₂;
 growing source of 0,2MtCO₂/yr



Ongoing improvement

- Regular data updates by Member States
- Ongoing work on projections at Member State and EU levels

→ updated and/or new data may be provided in the near future (e.g. for other 3.4 activities and projections).
