1. The branch may wish to consider the provisional agenda for adoption.

2. The branch may wish to consider the organization of its work for the meeting, including its schedule.

### 4. Provisions related to facilitation: Advice and facilitation

3. At its seventeenth meeting, the branch considered information and recommendations contained in the reports of the individual reviews of annual submissions and the reports of the technical reviews of national communications (hereinafter referred to as “review reports”) in the context of providing advice and facilitation to Parties on implementing the Kyoto Protocol. The branch noted the need for further work to advance its understanding on how to exercise this mandate and also noted that for this purpose it would be useful to have ‘case studies’. In this regard, members and alternate members could identify issues in the review reports relating to the implementation of the Kyoto Protocol and bring them to the attention of the branch.<sup>1</sup> The secretariat, with the agreement of the chairperson, requested members and alternate members to bring such matters to the attention of the branch no later than 1 August 2015.

4. The branch may wish to continue its discussions on this matter, taking into account the issues that have been identified by members and alternate members in the review reports in accordance with its functions set out in section IV of the “Procedures and mechanisms relating to compliance under the Kyoto Protocol” contained in the annex to decision 27/CMP.1.

5. The branch may wish to consider when to meet next, taking into account its expected workload.
