5. At its thirteenth meeting, the plenary agreed to look further into the issue of privileges and immunities at its next meeting, inter alia, by examining any such arrangements under other treaty bodies and compliance mechanisms.

6. The plenary will be invited to consider the issue of privileges and immunities with a view to outlining any relevant considerations in its report to the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP).

8. At its fifth meeting, the plenary decided to keep the issues of consistency of the review process under Article 8 of the Kyoto Protocol and resource limitations, including lack of available experts, under review at future meetings.¹

9. At its fourteenth meeting, the plenary confirmed the desirability of another joint workshop with inventory lead reviewers. It agreed to further discuss the scope of a possible workshop at its next meeting, taking into account the suggestions made by the facilitative branch,² the report by the chairperson of the facilitative branch at the fourteenth meeting of the plenary³ and any suggestions from the members and alternate members of the Compliance Committee submitted in advance of the fifteenth meeting of the plenary.⁴

10. The plenary will be invited to consider the matters referred to in paragraphs 8 and 9 above.

9. Implications for the work of the Compliance Committee arising from the timing of the entry into force of the Doha Amendment to the Kyoto Protocol

11. At its thirteenth meeting, the plenary considered the secretariat's note on possible implications for the work of the Compliance Committee in the second commitment period arising from decision 1/CMP.8.⁵ It agreed to further consider any implications for its work arising from the timing of the entry into force of the Doha Amendment to the Kyoto Protocol, contained in annex I to decision 1/CMP.8, at its fifteenth meeting.⁶

12. The plenary will be invited to consider the matter.
