Dear Mr. Bondi Ogolla,

On October 12, 2011, the enforcement branch of the Compliance Committee of the Kyoto Protocol has adopted the final decision (CC-2011-2-9/Ukraine/EB) concerned to Ukraine. In accordance with paragraph 8 of section IX, paragraph 1 (f) of section X, and rule 22 of the Rules of procedure the enforcement branch confirmed the preliminary finding by this decision.

In accordance with Section X, paragraph 2 of the Procedures and mechanisms relating to compliance under the Kyoto Protocol adopted by Decision 27/CMP.1, herewith Ukraine submits its request to reinstate its eligibility suspended with the final decision of the enforcement branch, adopted in Bonn on 12 October 2011.

The request to reinstate is based on the following conclusions, as stated in the Report of the individual review of the annual submission of Ukraine submitted in 2011 (FCCC/ARR/2011/UKR):


- The ERT concluded that the national system of Ukraine performs its required functions. Ukraine has put in place the mandatory requirements for a national system under Article 5, paragraph 1, of the Kyoto Protocol and the national system is generally prepared in accordance with the "Guidelines for national systems under Article 5, paragraph 1, of the Kyoto Protocol" (decision 19/CMP.1);
- The ERT concluded that the national system of Ukraine demonstrates a considerable improvement since the last annual submission;
- The ERT concluded that no questions of implementation were identified during the review.

We kindly request to consider an adoption of a decision as for reinstating the eligibility of Ukraine on the 18th meeting of the enforcement branch, which will be held 7-8 and 10 February 2012.
