Information on the quantified emission limitation or reduction objective (QELRO) for Norway

"A range of QELRO's from 81-84 is consistent with the Norwegian target of 30% reduction of emissions by 2020, compared to 1990, including the effect of changes in rules decided in Durban, and changes in relevant assumptions." (2013-2020)

On 2020 target

- In 2007, Norway put forward a target of 30% reduction of emissions by 2020, compared to 1990, with certain background assumptions (FCCC/KP/AWG/2010/INF.2/Rev.1).
- Norway will move to a level of 40% reduction for 2020 as part of a global and comprehensive agreement for the period beyond 2012 where major emitting Parties agree on emission reductions in line with the 2 degree Celsius target (letter of association with the Copenhagen Accord)
- In the Kyoto context, these conditions are not fulfilled.
- In the submission, information is therefore given relative to an emission reduction of 30% by 2020, compared to 1990
