## AWG-KP in Doha: Status – Issues – Solutions

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## Status: AWG-KP before Doha

- Significant progress in Durban in 2011
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> commitment period (CP2) to start on 1 Jan. 2013
  - Many CP2 rules agreed
  - Follow-up work at SBSTA and SBI: outcomes expected in Doha
- Challenges for Doha
  - Adopt CP2 amendments, including CP2 length and CP2 QELROs
  - Address "legal" and "operational" continuity from 1 Jan.2013
  - Complete the work of AWG-KP (started in 2005)
- AWG-KP negotiating text published on 9 October
  - Based on proposals from Parties up-to-date
  - Contains clear options for most (not yet all) issues
  - Agreement on key AWG-KP issues appears "within reach"

## Remaining issues (all important)

- 1) Text from Durban (1/CMP.7) or also post-Durban inputs?
  - Parties' views differ on what should be basis for Doha outcome
- 2) CP2 length ~ QELROs ~ ambition
  - QELROs = Annex I objectives/commitments
  - Options for CP2 length: 5 years (AOSIS, LDCs, Africa) or 8 years (Annex I Parties)
  - These are not separate issues but one issue with several facets
  - Not all Annex I Parties have submitted QELROs yet
- 3) Ensuring "legal continuity" from 1 January 2013
  - To prevent "gap" from 1 January 2013 until CP2 entry into force
- 4) Ensuring "operational continuity" from CP1 to CP2
  - "Eligibility": key to maintain mechanisms from 1 January 2013
  - "Eligibility": two facets for CP2 Parties and non-CP2 Parties
  - Decisions will have implications on the carbon market
- 5) "Carry-over" & "surplus" of tradable units from CP1 to CP2
  - Most relevant to AAUs (assigned amount units) from CP1 to CP2
  - Consolidated G77&China proposal is on the table
  - Still a difficult issue (option of "no change" also on the table)

## Options for solutions

1	Length = 8 years, QELROs from Annex I Parties
2	Length = 5 years, QELROs from AOSIS
3	Length = 8 years, QELROs from Annex I Parties plus "review" or "forfeit" in CP2
	Ensuring "legal continuity": discussions are advancing well
	How to enable "toolbox": provisional application / unilateral declarations / decisions
	Eligibility for CP2 Parties: major issue (informal consultations in Nov.)
	How to ensure continuation of mechanisms before CP2 entry into force?
	How to link AWG-KP decisions with ongoing technical work under SBSTA/SBI?
	Eligibility for non-CP2 Parties: divergent views
	"No" to any access to KP mechanisms? If "yes": all mechanisms or CDM only?
	Carry-over/surplus: unlimited or limited (if limited, how?)
