



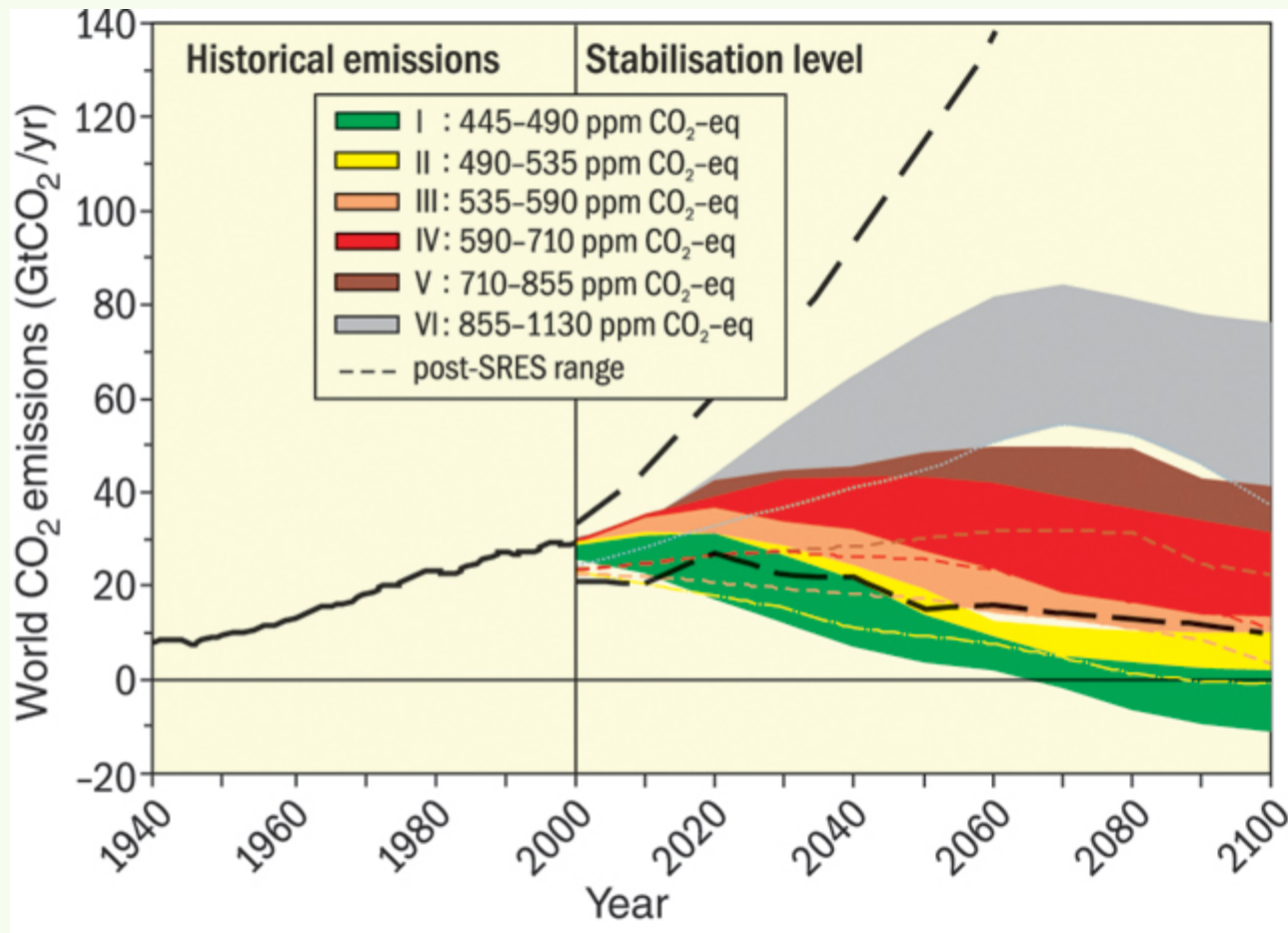

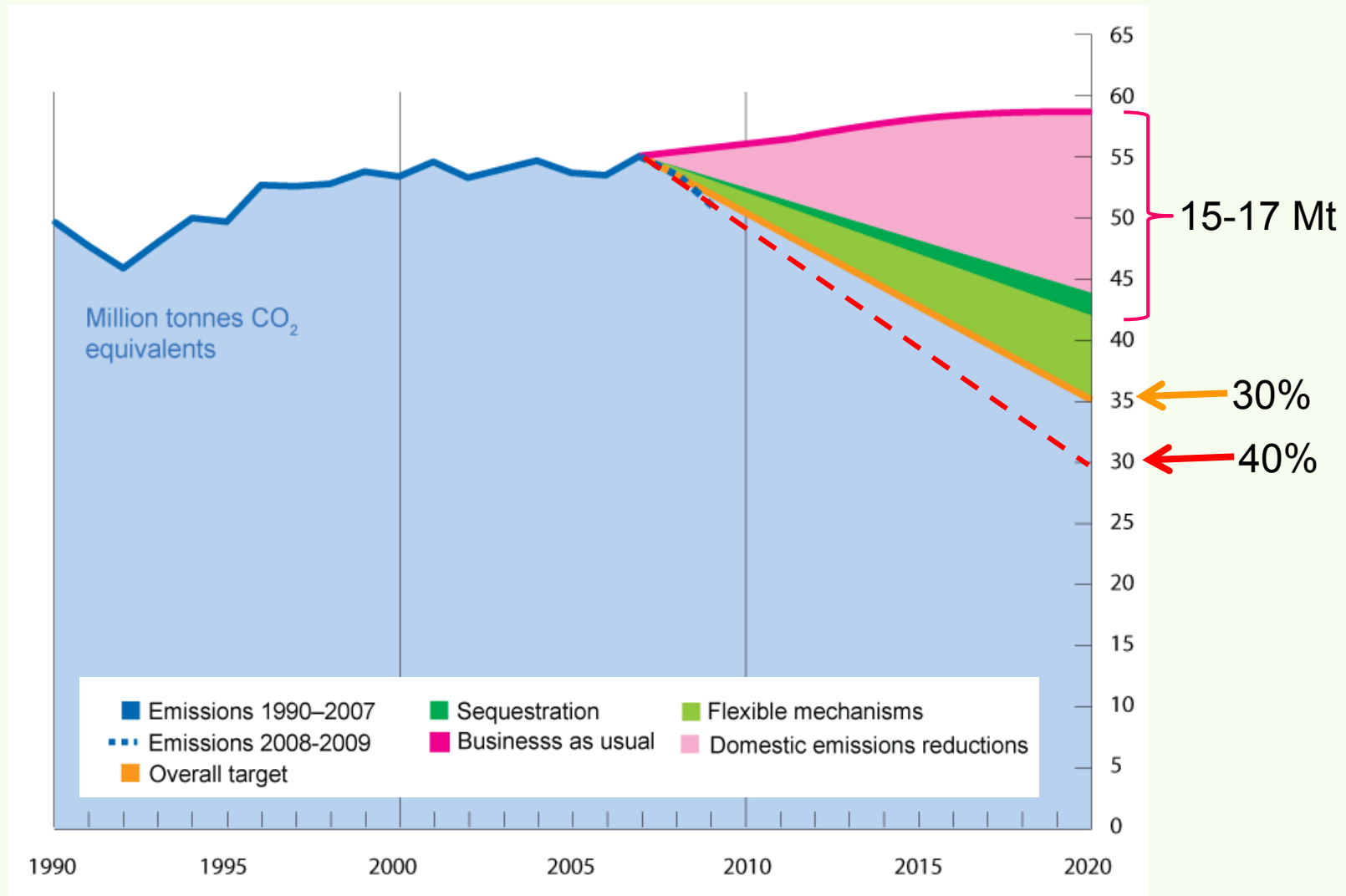

# Norway's emission reduction commitments



## Rules for LULUCF should give incentives for additional mitigation

- Significant implications of changes in rules for accounting for LULUCF emissions and removals
- Countries' targets must be revised accordingly, keeping ambition level unchanged.
- Under the current rules for Article 3.3 and 3.4 :
  - Estimated removal in Norway for 2020 is 3 million tonnes, corresponding to 6 per cent of our 1990 emissions.
- Norway intends to revise its commitments in accordance with rule changes, with the aim of keeping the overall high ambition level unchanged

## Norway's emission reduction targets

- By 2020:
  - Reduce global greenhouse gas emissions by the equivalent of 30 percent of its own 1990 emissions.
  - Aim that about 2/3 of emission reductions will be cuts in domestic emissions
  - Significant implications of rules for LULUCF
- In context of global and comprehensive agreement:
  - Reduction target of 40 per cent by 2020
  - Carbon neutrality by 2030
- Includes the use of flexible mechanisms
