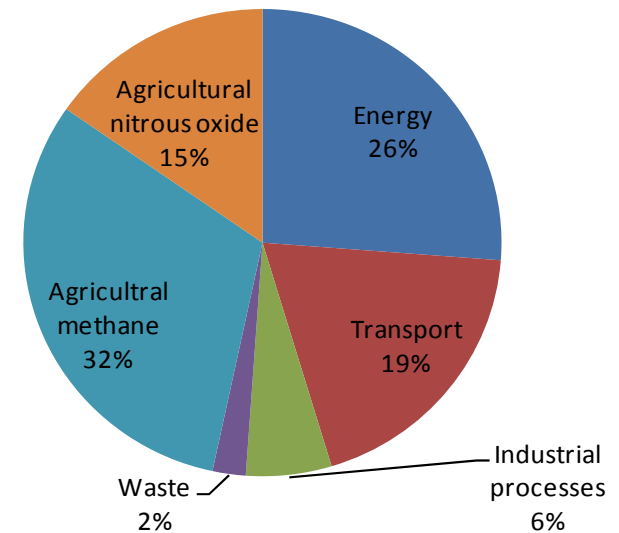

Targets in context: **National Circumstances**

- ~0.2% of global emissions
- Emissions profile
- NZ Emissions Trading Scheme
- Well on track for CP1

New Zealand's total greenhouse emissions for 2008



- Global Research Alliance on Agricultural Greenhouse Gases



New Zealand's 2020 Target: 10 to 20% below 1990 levels by 2020

- Conditional on:

- Global agreement sets path to limit rise to 2°C
- Comparable effort from Developed countries
- Advanced and major emitting Developing countries take action in line with their capability
- Full recourse to broad and efficient markets
- Effective set of rules for LULUCF
