


# Developed country pledges: Where are parties after Cancun?

- 1. Adopted: 2°C goal
- 2. Agreed: consider moving to 1.5°C
- 3. Recognised: 25-40% range for developed countries
- 4. Agreed: scaled-up effort necessary to
  - achieve the global goal
  - move developed countries into 25-40% range

Current developed country pledges are far below the IPCC 25-40% range, making them inconsistent with 1.5°C/2°C.

### How big is the gap?





### **Clarifications needed**

- Developed countries must clarify <u>what their true</u> <u>emissions will be</u>, i.e. their assumptions on forests and other land use accounting, the use of carbon offsets and hot air carry-over, in order to close all loopholes.
- Developed countries with current pledges below the 25-40% range must explain how their low pledges
  - should be <u>compensated for by other developed</u> <u>countries</u> making higher cuts instead,
  - are consistent with their fair share of the globally needed mitigation effort.



### **Clarifications needed** (continued)

- 3. Developed countries whose pledges are
  - below their current Kyoto targets, and/or
  - below BAU under existing domestic legislation and targets (e.g. efficiency targets), must explain <u>how those pledges constitute progress</u>.
- Developed countries must explain how their 2020 pledges will allow them to <u>achieve near-zero</u> <u>emissions</u> by 2050.
