

Africa Group submission on the review

2 October 2011

This submission presents inputs made by the Africa Group that are not reflected in the facilitators note version of 17 June @ 10.00.

Further definition of its scope

- *Affirming* that the review of the adequacy of the long-term global goal and overall progress towards achieving it can only be effective in the context of the review of the adequacy and effectiveness of urgent compliance by Annex I Parties with their commitments for effecting deep cuts in their emissions, and by Annex II Parties for provision of financial resources and transfers of technology and capacity to developing countries under the UNFCCC.
- *Reaffirming* that the adequacy of the long-term global goal can only be understood in the context of such a goal ensuring that emission reductions are at a level that allows ecosystems to adapt naturally to climate change, to ensure that food production is not threatened and to enable economic development to proceed in a sustainable manner, and that the extent of adaptation costs is contingent on achieving the necessary emission reductions.

Modalities

- *Agrees* that the periodical reviews should be further consistent with reporting cycles of mechanism under the Convention on means of implementation by the Finance Mechanism, Technology Mechanism and the Cancun Adaptation Framework.

The review should consider

- Adequacy of means of implementation, finance, technology, capacity building support for developing countries to fulfil their mitigation and adaptation obligations under the Convention, consistent with principles of the Convention.

Activities

- *Requests* the Subsidiary Body for Implementation to consider information on finance technology support to developing countries by developed countries in their sixth National Communications, as well as financial and technological needs of developing countries as

reflected in their second National Communications, as well as any relevant information from Intergovernmental and Multilateral Organisations

- *Requests* the secretariat to organize workshops in the period 2013 to 2014 for Parties, with relevant Intergovernmental Organisations, Multilateral Bodies making presentations on any matter within the scope of the review, particularly on finance, technology, capacity building support for developing countries

Inputs

- National Communications and reporting mechanisms under the Convention on Finance and Technology transfer, including reports by Intergovernmental, Multilateral Organisations, and technical reports that can provide further information on these aspects

Who conducts the review

Timeline for the first review

Appropriate action by the Conference of the Parties

Consider adequacy of agreed to objectives for finance to developing countries, effectiveness of technology transfer to developing countries, adequacy of adaptation support in relation to the agreed to global temperature goal, and submit recommendations to the CoP for consideration at its twenty first session.
