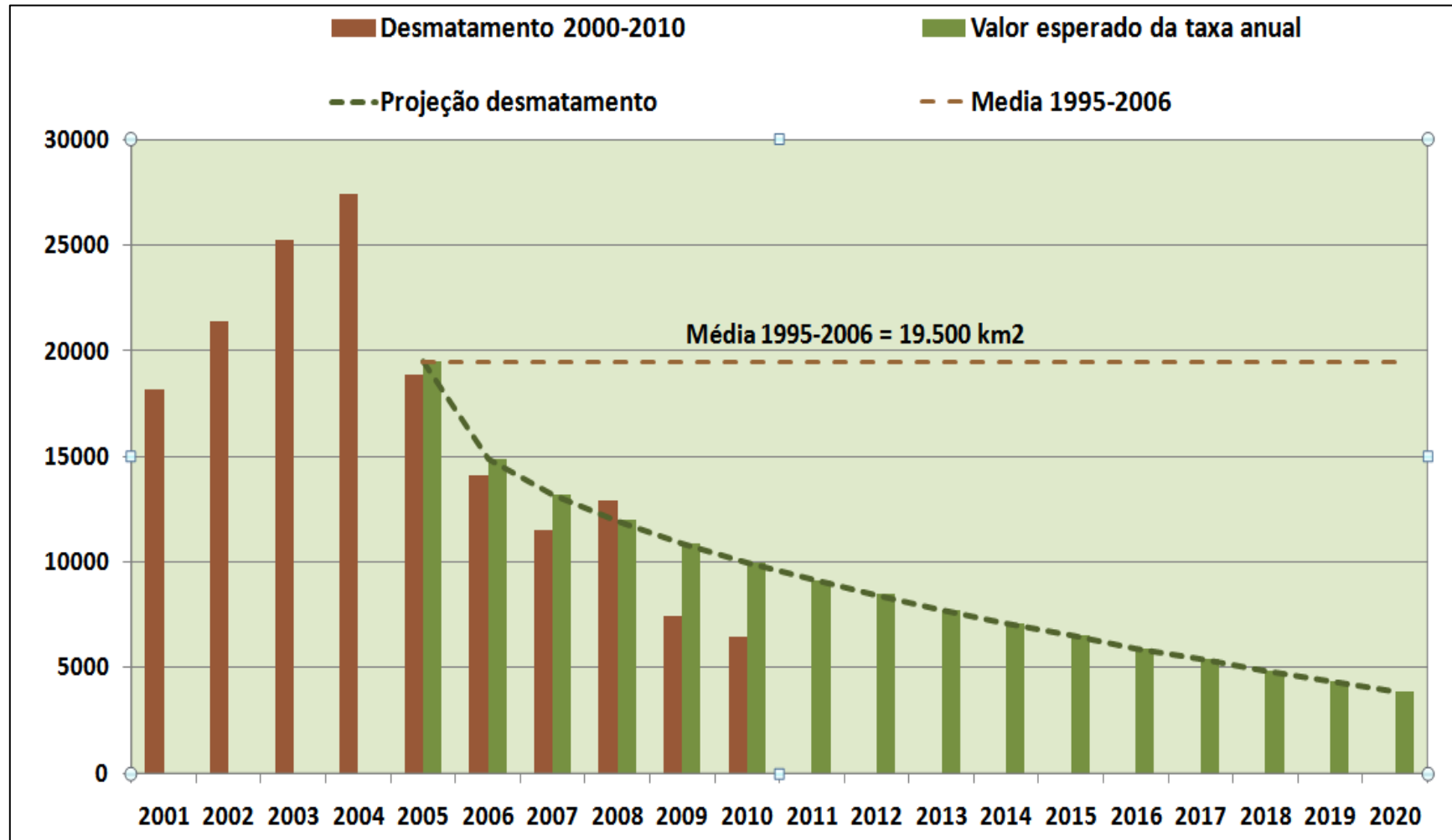


Mitigation in Brazil

- Implementation of significant mitigation actions, without conditioning its efforts to the level of mitigation of others.
- Broad stakeholder participation, which resulted in a National Law and National Plan.
- Brazil expects from developed countries simply what has been agreed internationally: financial and technological support.
- Our actions have generated opportunities for South-South cooperation in areas such as REDD and agriculture.
