



Process for the selection of a host to the CTC



Process should be open, transparent fair and neutral


Host should present inter alia



- •Willingness to host
- •Organisational structure with management, team members and
- methodological approaches
- •Demonstration of expertise and knowledge of technology processes
- Involvement with the private sector
- •Cost estimates

CTC: competences and capabilities





Competences and capabilities should be in line with the Terms of reference of the CTC, in particular with its objectives and tasks;



Preference for an intergovernmental institution in the UN system



Project understanding must be demonstrated, in particular, in relation to advice and support in the development, dissemination and transfer of Environmentally Sound Technologies, participation in international technology partnerships, knowledge and/or participation in elaboration of best practices for country-driven planning



Years of experience and competences in the field should be considered in the selection.
