

TEC and the CTC




- TEC and CTC will relate to promote coherence and synergies (para127)
- CTC facilitates access to a network: CTC shall operate independently within it's terms of reference and take into account the strategic guidance provided by TEC.
- CTC and TEC report on an interim basis to the SBs on it's performance and activities and the performance of their respective functions
- TEC recommendations to be provided directly to the Conference of the Parties; COP decides which recommendations it will take into account

Relationship with other institutional arrangements




- Clear separation between strategic policy level advice (from the TEC) and operational aspects related to the work of the entities entrusted with the financial mechanism
