



**ADDITIONAL SUBMISSION BY POLAND AND THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION ON BEHALF OF THE EUROPEAN UNION AND ITS 27 MEMBER STATES**

*Panama, 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2011*

**Subject: EU additional submission to be included in the facilitator's note on 'shared vision'**

Developed countries should continue to take the lead by committing to ambitious legally binding quantified emission reduction commitments. They should commit to collectively reducing their emissions of GHGs in the order of 30% by 2020 compared to 1990 levels. In accordance with the findings of the IPCC AR4, developed countries as a group should reduce their GHG emissions by 25-40% below 1990 levels by 2020. They should also agree to an aggregate developed country emission reduction of at least 80-95% by 2050 compared to 1990 levels as part of a global emission reduction of at least 50% by 2050 compared to 1990 levels.

As a group developing countries should achieve a substantial deviation below the currently predicted emissions growth rate in the order of 15 to 30% by 2020 respecting the principle of common but differentiated responsibilities and respective capabilities.
