

Submission by Saudi Arabia to be included in the next iteration of the non-paper on Review (Agenda Item 4).

These bullets are to be included in the section on “further definition of scope”

- The adverse social and economic impacts on developing country parties, as a result of mitigation commitments and actions seeking to contribute to the aspiration goals; including the cost and impacts on the poverty eradication and economic development of developing countries.
- The adequacy of means of implementation provided for developing countries to meet their needs for adaptation and voluntary mitigation
- The financial and technological needs by developing country parties to undertake adaptation and voluntary mitigation actions to contribute, on the basis of equity, towards the achievement of the aspiration goals.
- The extent to which the financing provided by developed countries to developing countries is “new and additional”, adequate, predictable, stable, timeliness, grant-based and channeled through the UNFCCC’s financial mechanism.
- The types and extent of technologies being transferred by developed countries to developing countries, and the extent to which such technology transfer has been effective in supporting developing countries adaptation and voluntary mitigation actions.
