Proposal from Singapore on Shared Vision

Recalls Article 4.10 of the Convention that recognises the serious difficulties faced by some Parties in switching to alternatives to the use of fossil fuels.

Recognises that parties that are alternative energy disadvantaged, as a result of a lack of access to renewable sources of energy, face significant constraints in undertaking mitigation actions;

Decides, in identifying the timeframe for global peaking of greenhouse gas emissions, and in recognising that the timeframe for peaking will be longer in developing countries, to take into account the relevant provisions and principles of the Convention, including the mitigation potential of alternative energy disadvantaged Parties which have serious difficulties in switching to alternatives to the use of fossil fuels.
