Cancun MRV work program

- Biennial reports, including inventories
- International MRV of supported actions
- International Consultations and Analysis

(General guidance on domestic MRV)

Biennial Reports

Biennial reports, including GHG inventories

- Parties with greater capability/significant global emissions/actions listed
- LDCs, SIDS to report only at their discretion

National communications every 4 years

 For most non-Annex I Parties, with flexibility for LDCs and SIDS

Biennial report elements (1)

- Greenhouse gas inventory
- Mitigation actions
- Update on progress in implementation of actions
- Support received and needs

Biennial report elements (2)

Greenhouse gas inventory

- First biennial report
 - 1996 IPCC Guidelines, 2000 & 2003 Good Practice Guidance
 - UNFCCC software spreadsheets and common reporting format tables
 - National Inventory Report
- Further revised guidelines for subsequent biennial reports which will lead to improvements in reporting over time

Biennial report elements (3)

- Mitigation actions
 - Description of key actions
- Progress in implementation of actions
 - Status of implementation efforts
 - Performance indicators for measuring progress, methodologies and assumptions
 - Results of actions, including emission reductions or removals
 - Information on the use of tradeable units, including offsets

International Consultations and Analysis

To increase transparency of mitigation actions and their effects, non-intrusive, non-punitive, respectful of national sovereignty, facilitative in nature

International Consultations and Analysis

- Conducted by team of 5-8 technical experts
 drawn from roster of Party-nominated experts and Secretariat staff
- In consultation with Party, conduct analysis of:
 - Biennial report including GHG inventory
 - Information submitted and implementation of mitigation actions
- Experts prepare a summary report in consultation with the Party

International Consultations and Analysis

- Facilitative sharing of views among Parties under the SBI on the basis of biennial reports and expert analysis report
- Opportunity for written questions and response from Party
- Summary report, in consultation with Party
 - Objective overview of SBI consultations
 - Written questions and Party responses
 - Any observations from Party
