This message is being sent to Parties and Observers States to the Convention. It is addressed to their National Focal Points for Climate Change. For those Parties that have not yet identified National Focal Points, the message is being sent to the Diplomatic Missions in Bonn and to the Permanent Missions in New York or the Ministries of Foreign Affairs, as appropriate, of those Parties not represented in Bonn. In all cases, the communication is being copied to their Diplomatic Missions in Bonn and the Permanent Missions to the United Nations Office at Geneva.

A. <u>Dates and schedule of sessions</u>

The Executive Secretary wishes to announce the forthcoming sessions of the four subsidiary bodies of the Convention to be held at the Maritim Hotel, Godesberger Allee, D-53175 Bonn, from 28 July to 7 August 1997, as follows:

- Sixth session of the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA), during the period from 28 July to 5 August 1997;
- Sixth session of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) during the period from 28 July to 5 August 1997;
- Fifth session of the Ad Hoc Group on Article 13 (AG13), during the period from 28 July to 30 July 1997; and





- Seventh session of the Ad Hoc Group on the Berlin Mandate (AGBM), during the period from 31 July to 7 August 1997.
- B. Reports and Annotated Provisional Agendas
