This message is being sent to all intergovernmental organizations (IGOs) and non-governmental organizations (NGOs) admitted as observers by the Conference of the Parties at its first and second sessions, and to those observer organizations that have been provisionally admitted since COP 2 by the subsidiary bodies of the UNFCCC.

A. Dates and schedule of sessions

The Executive Secretary wishes to announce the forthcoming sessions of the three subsidiary bodies of the Convention to be held at the Beethovenhalle, Wachsbleiche 16, D-53111, Bonn, 20 to 31 October 1997, as follows:

- Seventh session of the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) from 20 to 29 October 1997;
- Seventh session of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) from 20 to 29 October 1997:
- Eighth session of the Ad Hoc Group on the Berlin Mandate (AGBM), from 22 to 31 October 1997.

The provisional agendas as well as the schedule of meetings for all sessions are attached for convenience. It will be noted that, at its meeting of 8 August 1997, the Bureau of the Conference of the Parties decided to modify the schedule of meetings contained in Document FCCC/SBI/1997/11.

The report of the Ad Hoc Group on Article 13 (FCCC/AG13/1997/4) will also be available.

C. Representation

The representation of intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations as observers at sessions of the Conference of the Parties (COP) and its subsidiary bodies is regulated, <u>inter alia</u>, by Article 7, paragraph 6, of the Convention. Furthermore, it will be recalled that, at its first session, the Conference agreed that "the secretariat should invite to the future sessions of the Conference and of its subsidiary bodies all intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations admitted at the present session and at future sessions, unless an objection was raised to any particular organization in accordance with the Convention and the rules of procedure". Consequently, all organizations admitted at the sessions by the COP would be invited to the subsequent sessions, and the procedure for admission would apply only to new applicants. In addition, following the practice of the UNFCCC, the secretariat is sending this invitation to those organizations that have requested and been accorded provisional admission to the work of the subsidiary bodies since COP 2.

Communications to the Executive Secretary from all IGOs and NGOs admitted by the Conference of the Parties concerning representation at the three sessions mentioned above should reach the secretariat by 30 September 1997, at the latest, at the following address:

Exhibitors are requested to submit their requests well in advance of the sessions. Space will be allocated on "a first come first served basis".

A provisional List of Participants for the three bodies will be issued on Monday, 20 October 1997. A revised final List of Participants will be issued on Friday, 31 October 1997.
