#### ✓ Definitions of PoA and CPA

- ✓ Registration requirements for PoA, including
  - Coordination by coordinating/managing entity
  - Possible coverage of multiple project types and scales
  - Possible hosting by multiple Parties
  - Setting eligibility for inclusion of CPAs

#### √ Features of CPA

- CPA corresponds to a project activity
- Hosting by a single Party

# ✓ Roles of Parties hosting or participating in PoA

- Approval (LoA), withdrawal
- Requesting for review of request for registration or issuance



#### ✓ Inclusion of CPAs in PoA

- Possible inclusion of unlimited number of CPAs
- Inclusion by DOE after eligibility check
- Inclusion at, or anytime after, the registration of PoA
- Possible exclusion if found erroneously included or on voluntary basis

# ✓ Monitoring, verification/certification and issuance for PoA

Possible separation in multiple batches of CPAs

#### ✓ Duration and renewal of PoA

- 7 years, renewable 3 times (max 28 years) for non-A/R PoAs
- 20 years, renewable 2 times (max 60 years) for A/R PoAs
- Renewal by updating the eligibility criteria for inclusion of CPAs, applying the valid version of methodology and updating baseline



## ✓ Crediting period and its renewal for CPAs

- To be defined for each CPA individually
- Same duration and renewal options as for project activities
- May not exceed the possible maximum PoA duration
- Same process for renewal as for inclusion
