It is mandatory to include the society on the process to establish national programs and strategies.

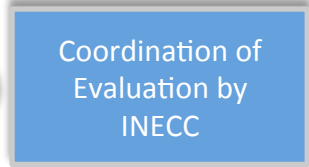
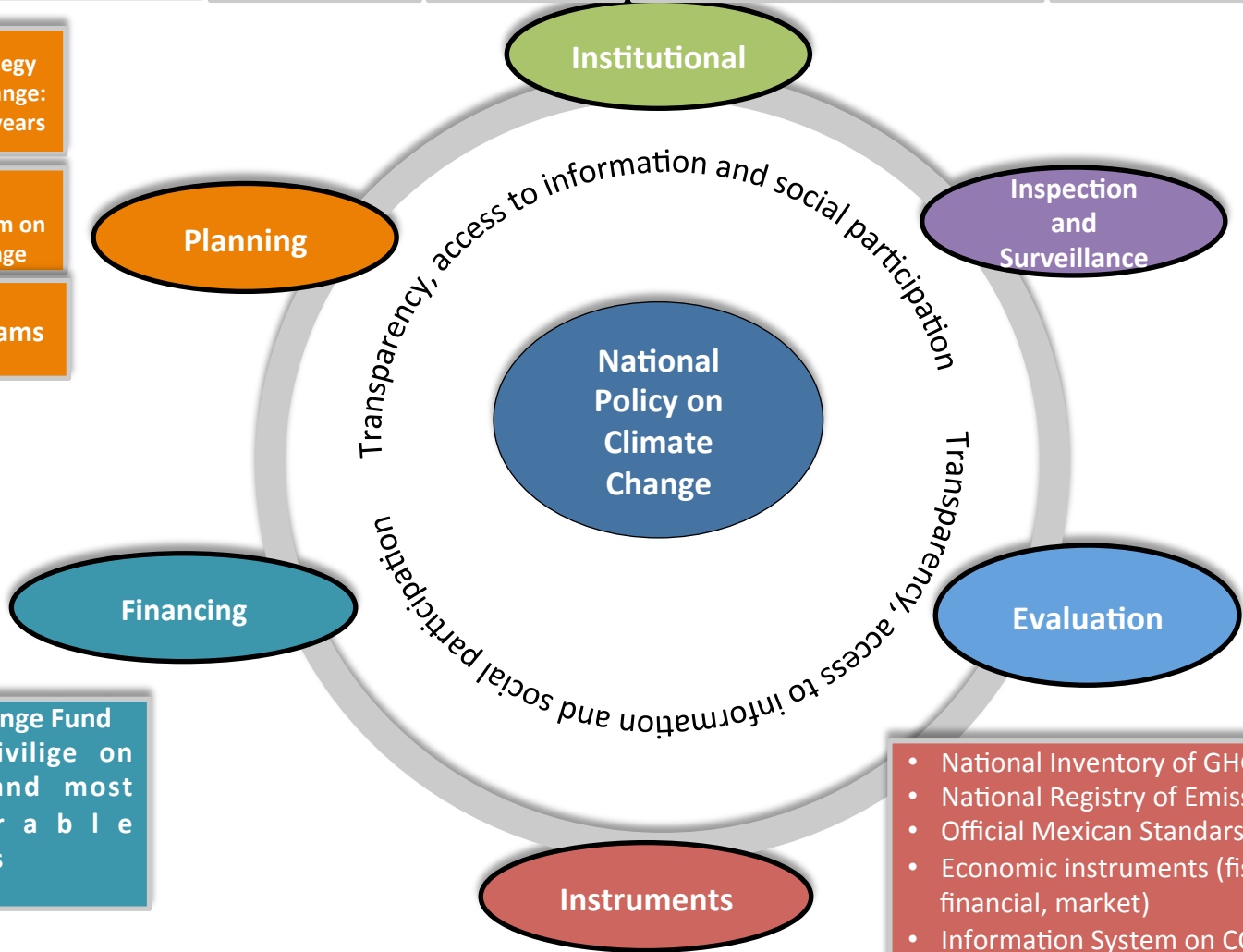
2) Special Program on Climate Change 2014-2018:

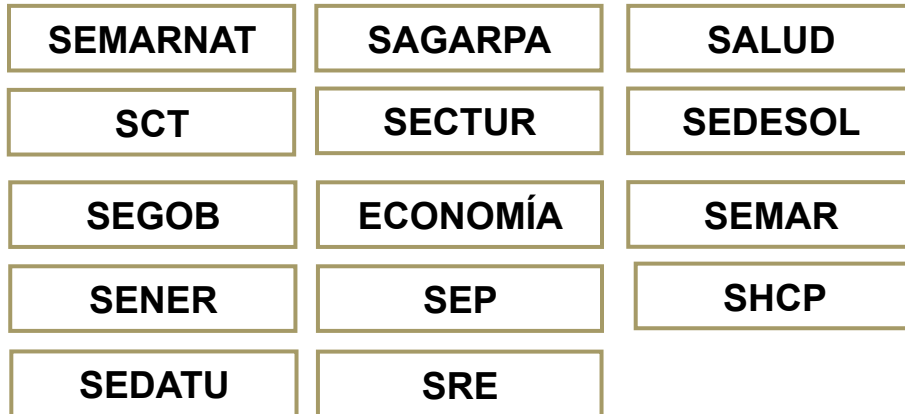

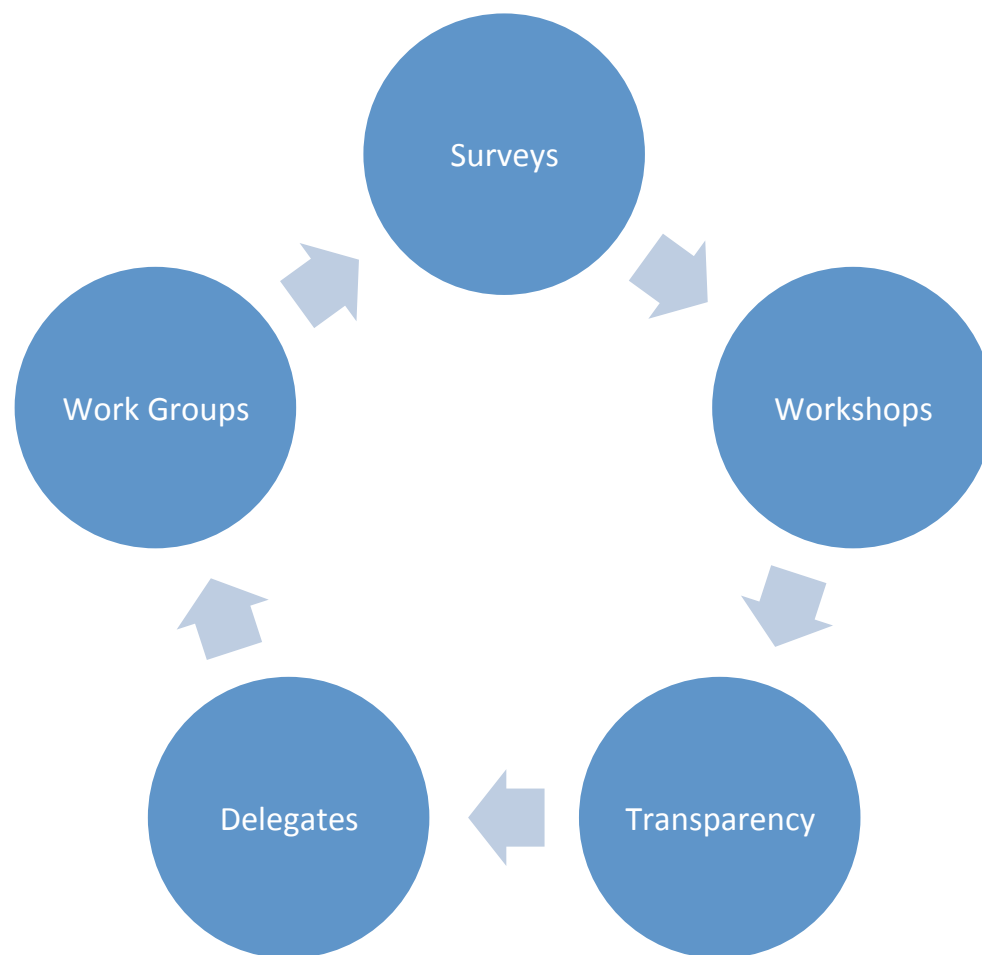
