- 6 social projects by families in Zoersel (alphabetization, handicapped, schools, organic waste treatment)
- Zoersel population direct support to population in Bohicon (EUR 1500/year)
- Subvention of agriculture expertise center
- Networking for Bohicon, incorporating Bohicon into our network.

Signing covenant of Mayors

- In May 2016, Zoersel Community council subscribed the engagement declaration for implementing SDG's in local governance and long term action plans.
- Zoersel, Covenant of Mayors 2030 Bohicon, Covenant of Mayors sub-Saharan Africa.
- Making climate action plan together. Colleagues working together.
- Same process to reach result with different actions.
- Zou province, where Bohicon is part of, is selected as pilot region for the covenant of Mayors by CEMR.

Problems Covenant of Mayors for sub Saharan cities

- Experiencing problems
 - Know how
 - Support (expertise, correct numbers how to measure emissions)
 - Cultural difference (waste = luxury)
 - Follow up
