

**Text proposals by G77 and China on the impact of the implementation of response measures for the draft agreement and decision presented by co-facilitators**

**G77 and China alternative proposal for Art. 2, par. 9 of the Draft Agreement:**

In accordance with the principles and provisions of the Convention, Parties shall give full consideration to what actions are necessary under the Convention, including actions related to funding, insurance and the transfer of technology, to meet the specific needs and concerns of developing country Parties arising from the impacts of the implementation of response measures, and taking into consideration that poverty eradication and social and economic development are the first and overriding priorities of developing country Parties. The COP shall strengthen institutional arrangements through a cooperative mechanism to address the adverse impacts of the implementation of response measures on developing country Parties, as included in Decision 1/CP 21.

**Paragraph 33 of the Draft decision text- G77 and China proposal for the provision on response measures:**

Parties decide to establish a cooperative mechanism by COP xx to address the specific needs and concerns of developing country Parties arising from the impacts of the implementation of response measures, by building on the work of the forum to develop a specific work program to be undertaken by the mechanism that shall be implemented with the view of recommending specific tools, actions and programs to address the impacts and the implementation gaps to avoid and minimize adverse effects on developing country Parties.
