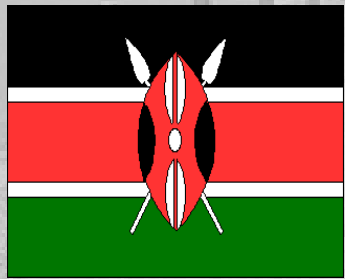

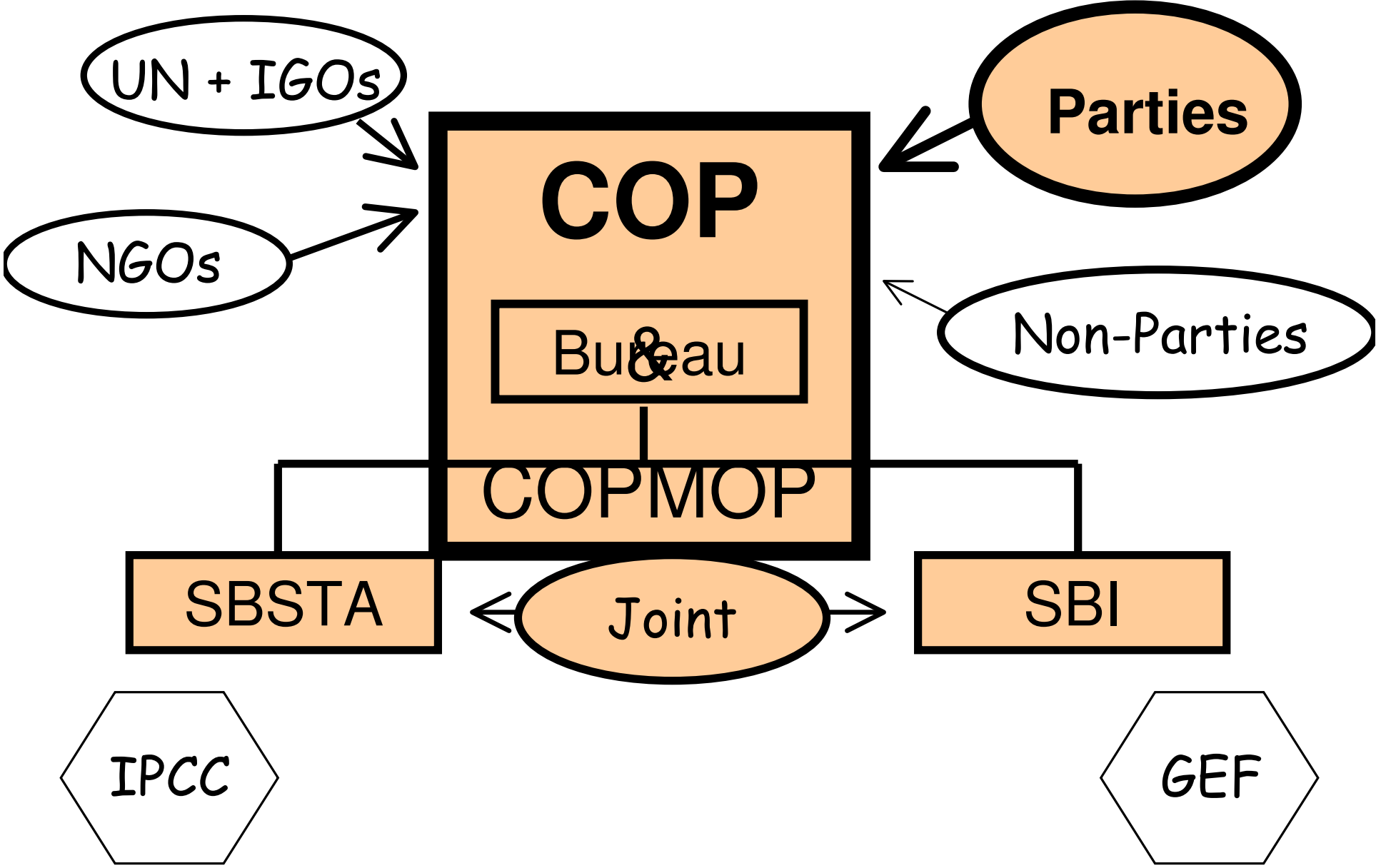

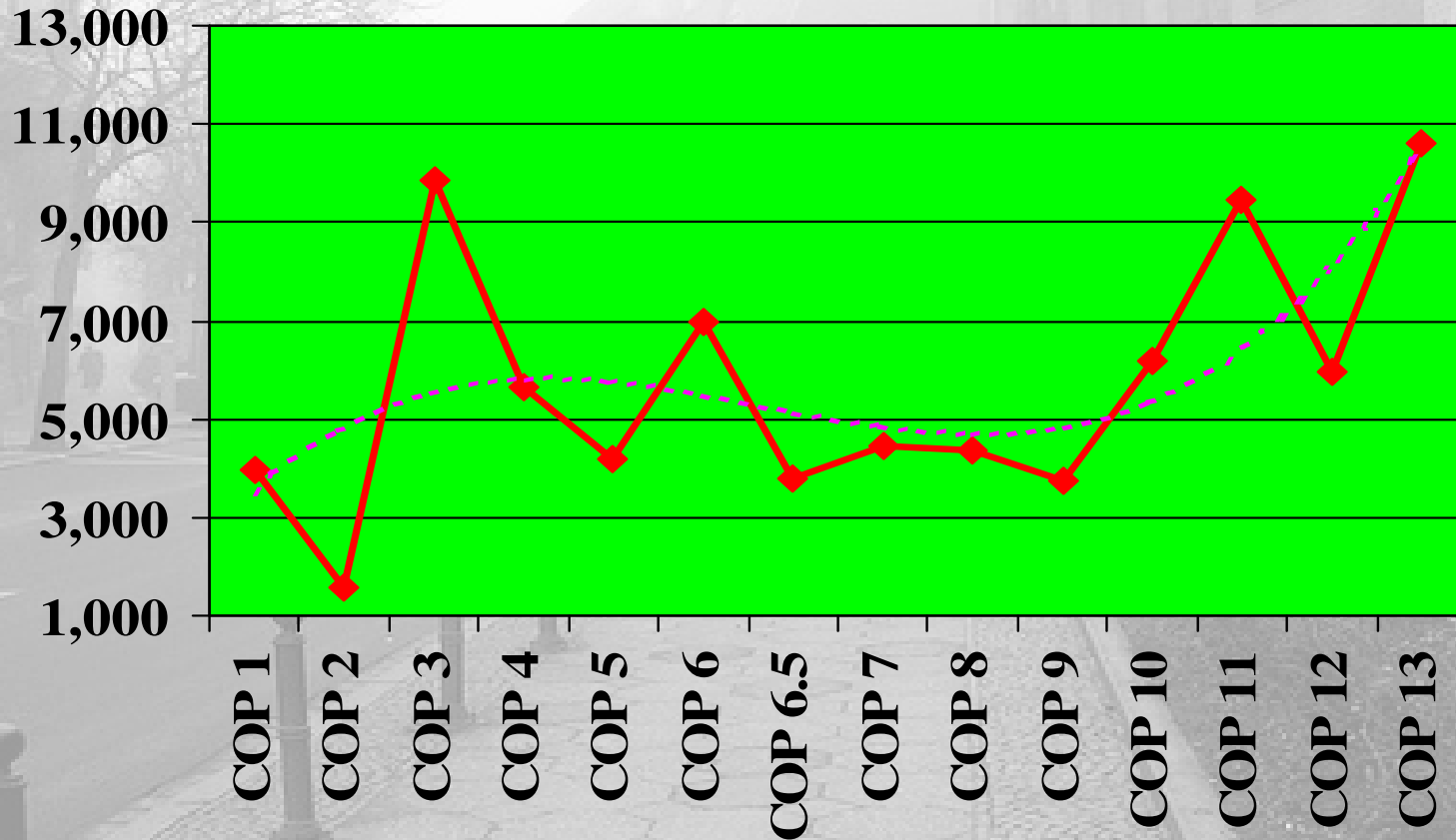

- **40 % increase (357) over Bali of applications for Side Events**
- **20 % increase of applications from UN agencies**

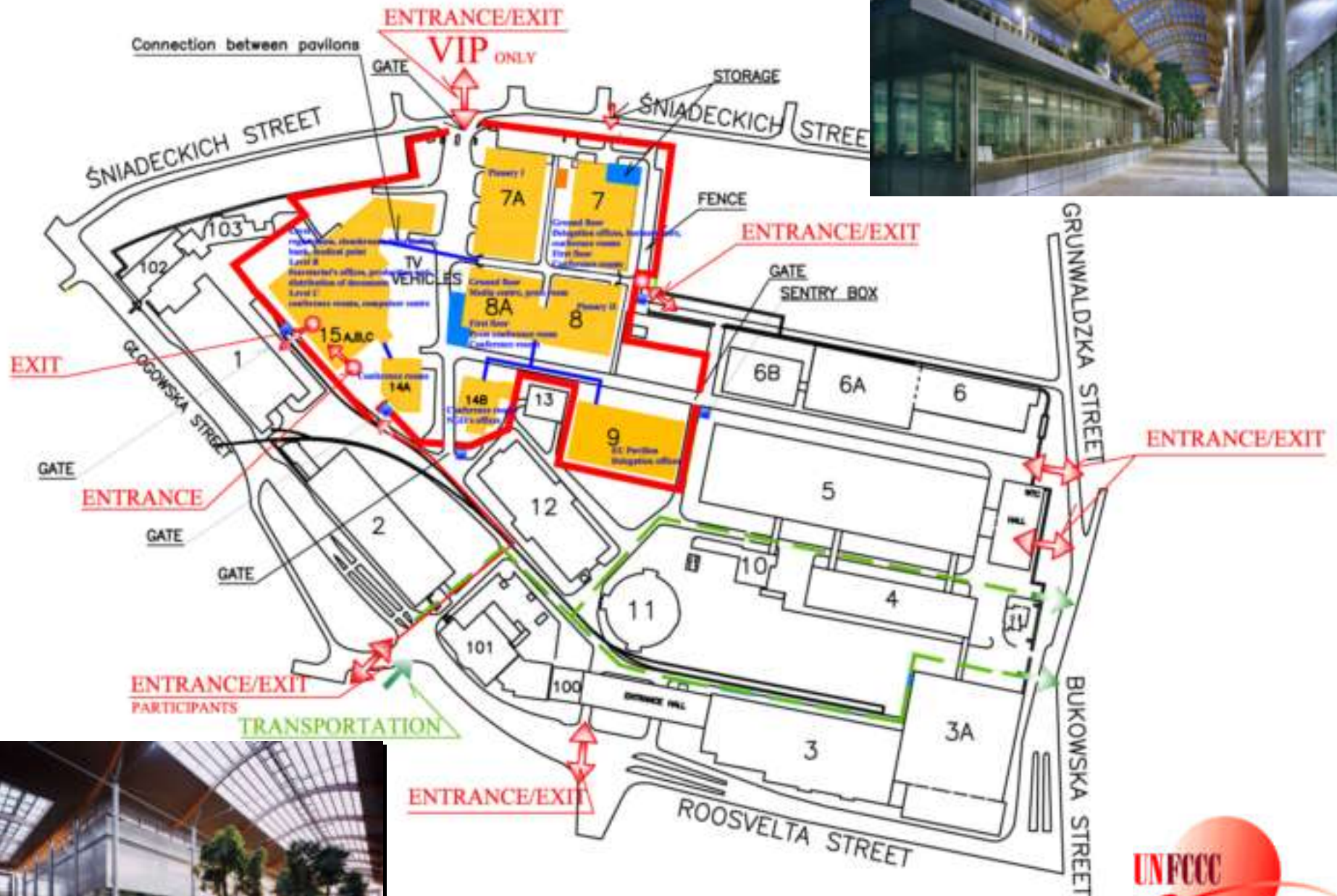

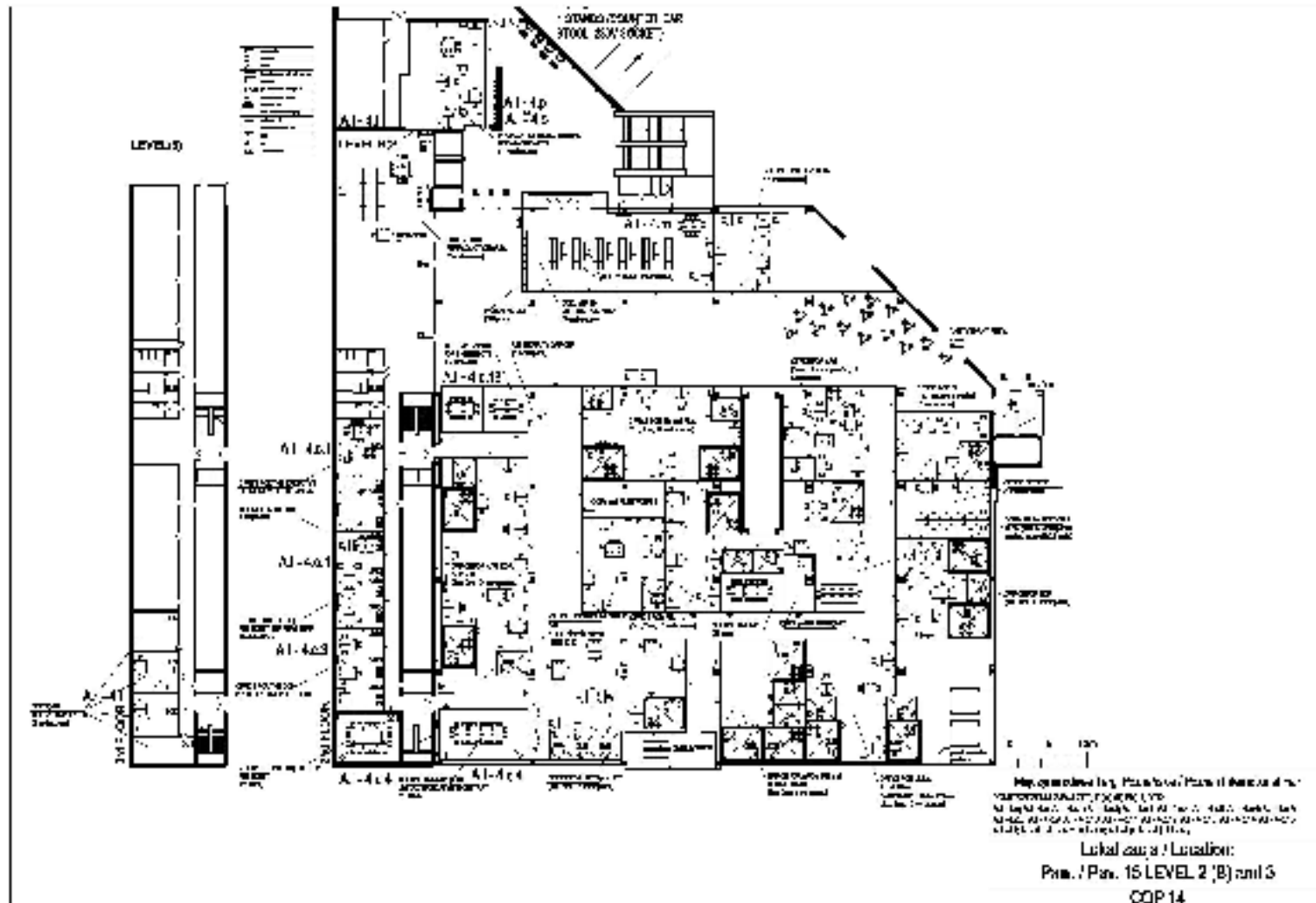
