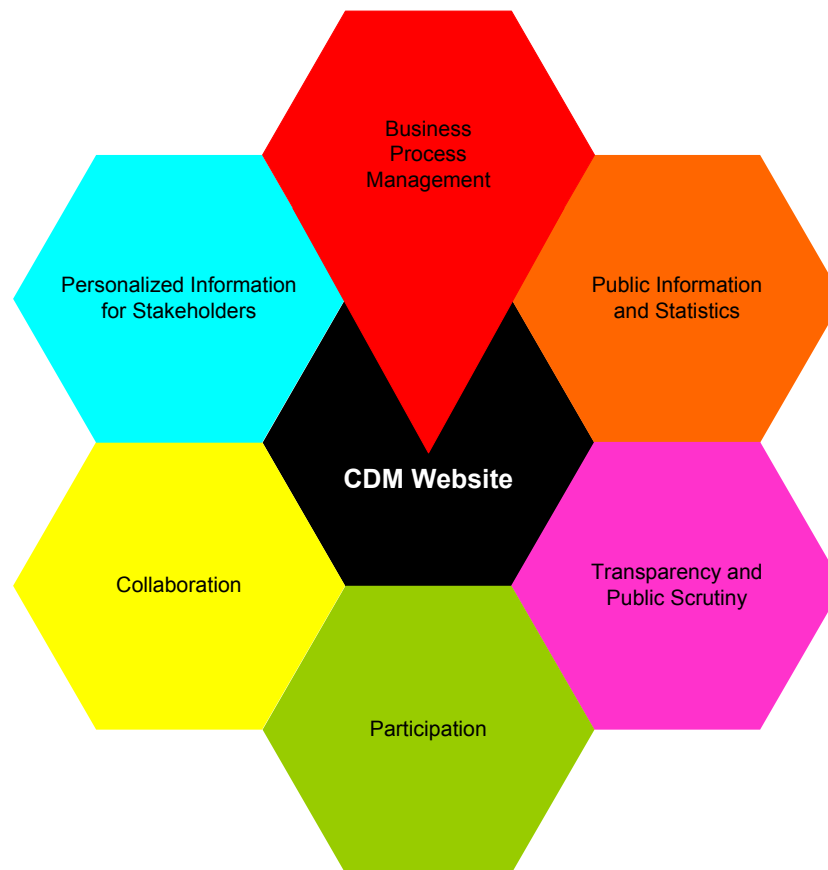

The baseline is the scenario that represents the GHG emissions that would occur in the absence of the proposed CDM project activity. The project participants can either use the approved methodologies or propose a new methodology for determining the baseline scenario.
