Dear Yvo,

Greetings from Indonesia!

From the outset, I would like to underline Indonesia's support on the global effort to reduce the GHG concentration in the atmosphere. Please be reaffirmed that the Government of Indonesia fully endorses the Copenhagen Accord, particularly in bringing all parties together to increase efforts toward stabilization of global temperature to a level that does not exceed two degree Celsius in the near future.

We are now finalizing the National Action Plan to materialize 26 to 41 percent CO₂ equivalent emission reduction in the country. To place this plan in power, a Presidential Decree as the basis of the National Action Plan is envisaged. Based on our analysis, to achieve the 2020 emission reduction cut as mentioned above, there are seven major areas to focus on, namely: peat-land, forestry, agriculture, energy, industry, transportation, and waste. In addition, the Action Plan will be equipped with an MRV system to ensure that each action deserves compensation.

The Indonesia National Council on Climate Change will update the UNFCCC Secretariat on the progress. I am sure, with your continued support and guidance; we will arrive at a fruitful solution in tackling global problem of climate change.
