## Copenhagen Accord

Dear Mr. De Boer,

At its fifteenth session, the Conference of the Parties of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change adopted a decision on 18 December 2009 taking note of the Copenhagen Accord. To finalize this decision, Parties are invited to indicate whether they wish to associate with this Accord and to submit their quantified economy-wide emission target for 2020 by 31 January 2010.

In this regard, I have the honour to inform you that on 26 January 2010 the Government of Liechtenstein decided as follows:

- Liechtenstein associates itself with the contents of the Copenhagen Accord and agrees that its name be included in the Chapeau of the Accord. The precise amount of Liechtenstein's contribution to the financial commitments outlined in paragraph 8 of the Accord is to be determined in the future and in particular subject to approval by the Liechtenstein Parliament.
- Liechtenstein commits itself to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions 20% below 1990 levels by 2020. If other developed countries agree to comparable reductions and emerging economies contribute according to their respective capabilities and responsibilities within a framework of a binding agreement, Liechtenstein is prepared to raise its target up to 30%.
