By means of this letter we acknowledge the reception of the letter sent by the Permanent Mission of Denmark to the United Nations, on December 30th, inviting Parties to the Convention to inform the UNFCCC Secretariat of their willingness to be associated with the "Copenhagen Accord".

In this respect, and taking into consideration the frame and conditions involved in the invitation, we are pleased to report that Peru expresses its willingness to associate with the Accord and is consequently taking the necessary steps to complete a full evaluation of the significance and scope of the commitments to be assumed.

As a result, we will send shortly, but not necessarily within the deadline stated in the text of the Accord, an additional communication about our perception regarding the issues that might require clarification and eventual inclusion in the terms of the Accord, including a more suitable timing for due evaluation and negotiation of terms for Non Annex I Parties.
